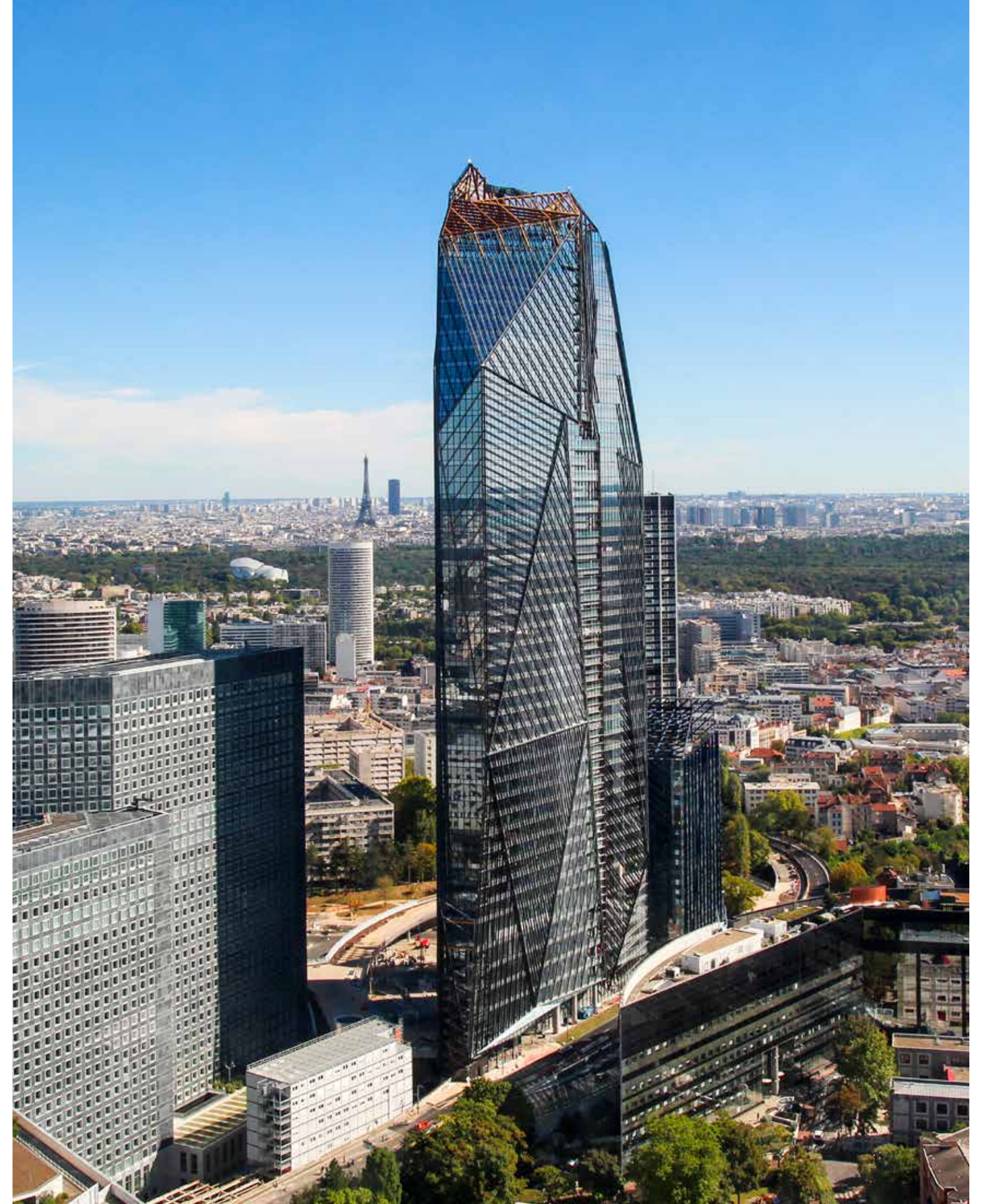

Hekla Tower

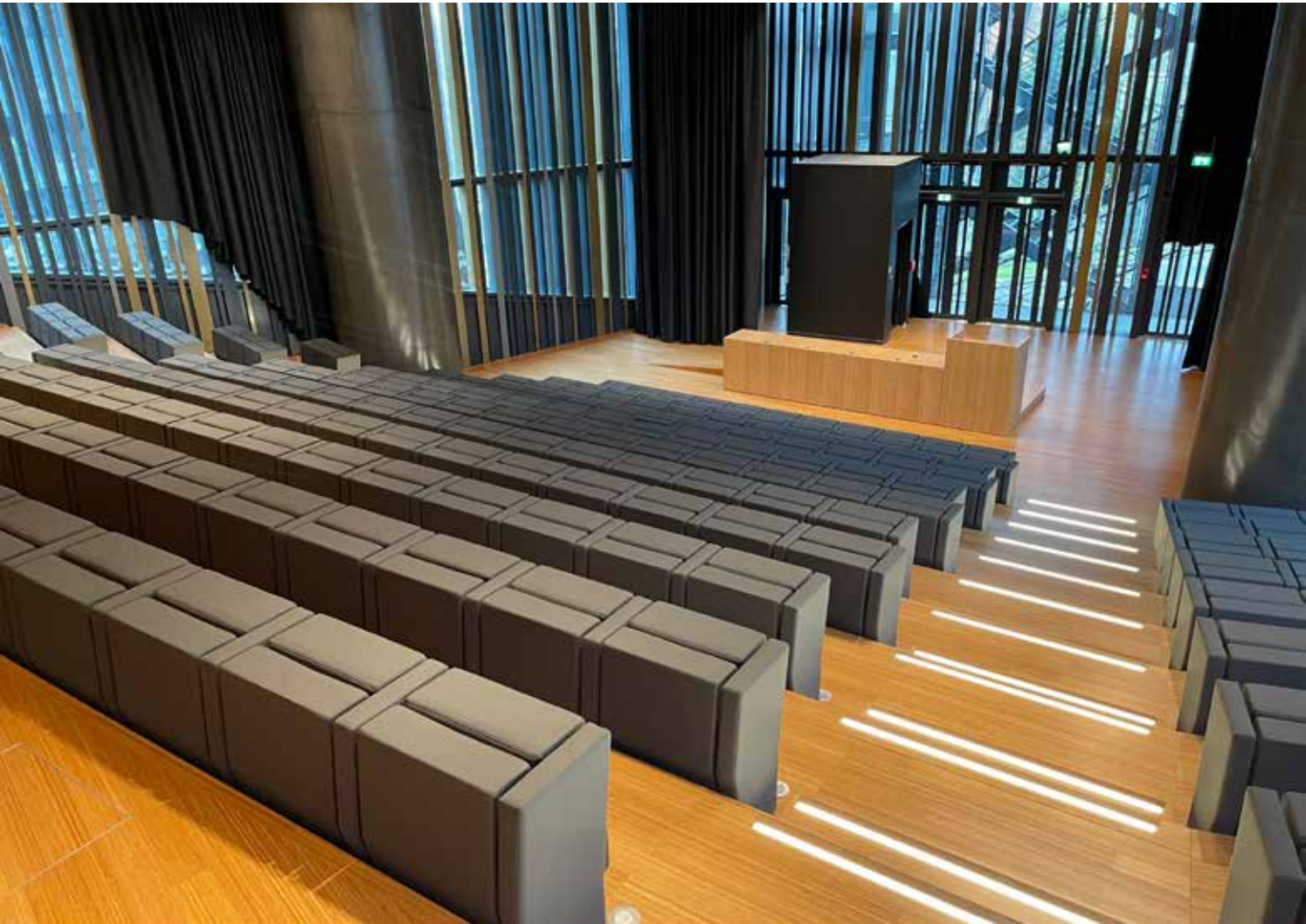
Hekla Tour is a 220 meters skyscraper designed by the famous French architect Jean Nouvel. Located in Paris La Defance area, it is 49 storey-high, covered with 45,000 square meters of solar glass, and has a distinctive prismatic shape. Hekla was created to meet office workers' aspirations, by building a new, comfortable, and healthy working environment.

The building comprises of 76,000 square meters of office space, 3 levels of housing, a Club space area, and a 250-seat Auditorium flooded with natural light.





For this unusual, and disruptive building experience, Poltrona Frau Custom Interiors cooperated in the customization of the 250 Close seats for the Auditorium. Originally designed by Jean Nouvel for the Abu Dhabi Louvre, Close chair is a compact, ergonomically shaped chair with a complex automatic locking system that allows a synchronized movement, and upholstered in Pelle Frau leather.



Poltrona Frau Custom Interiors is a distinguished and experienced partner for the creation of special seating projects like auditoriums, theatres, museums, Cinemas, and airports. It cooperates with architects from all over the world interpreting the spirit and philosophy of their projects. 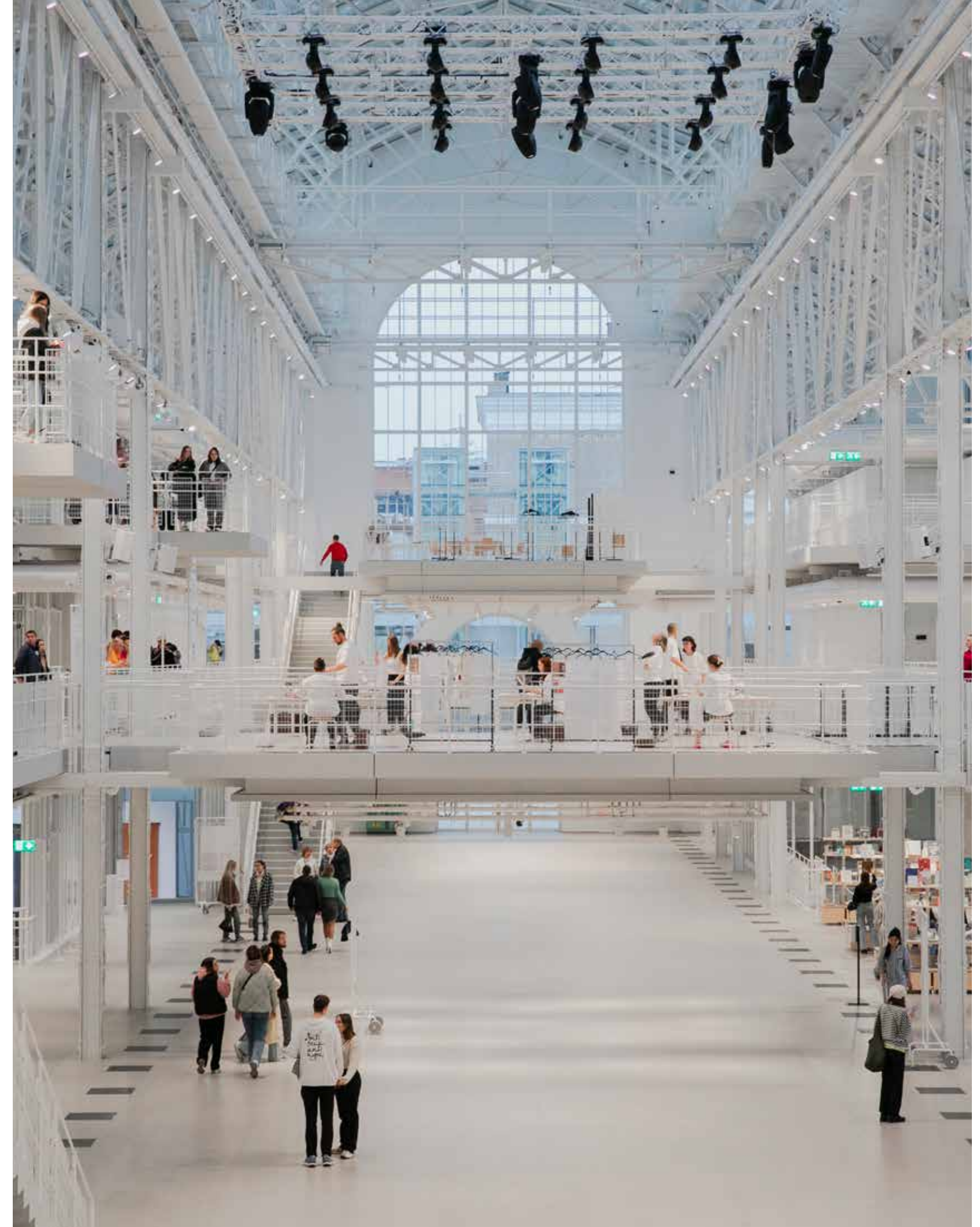

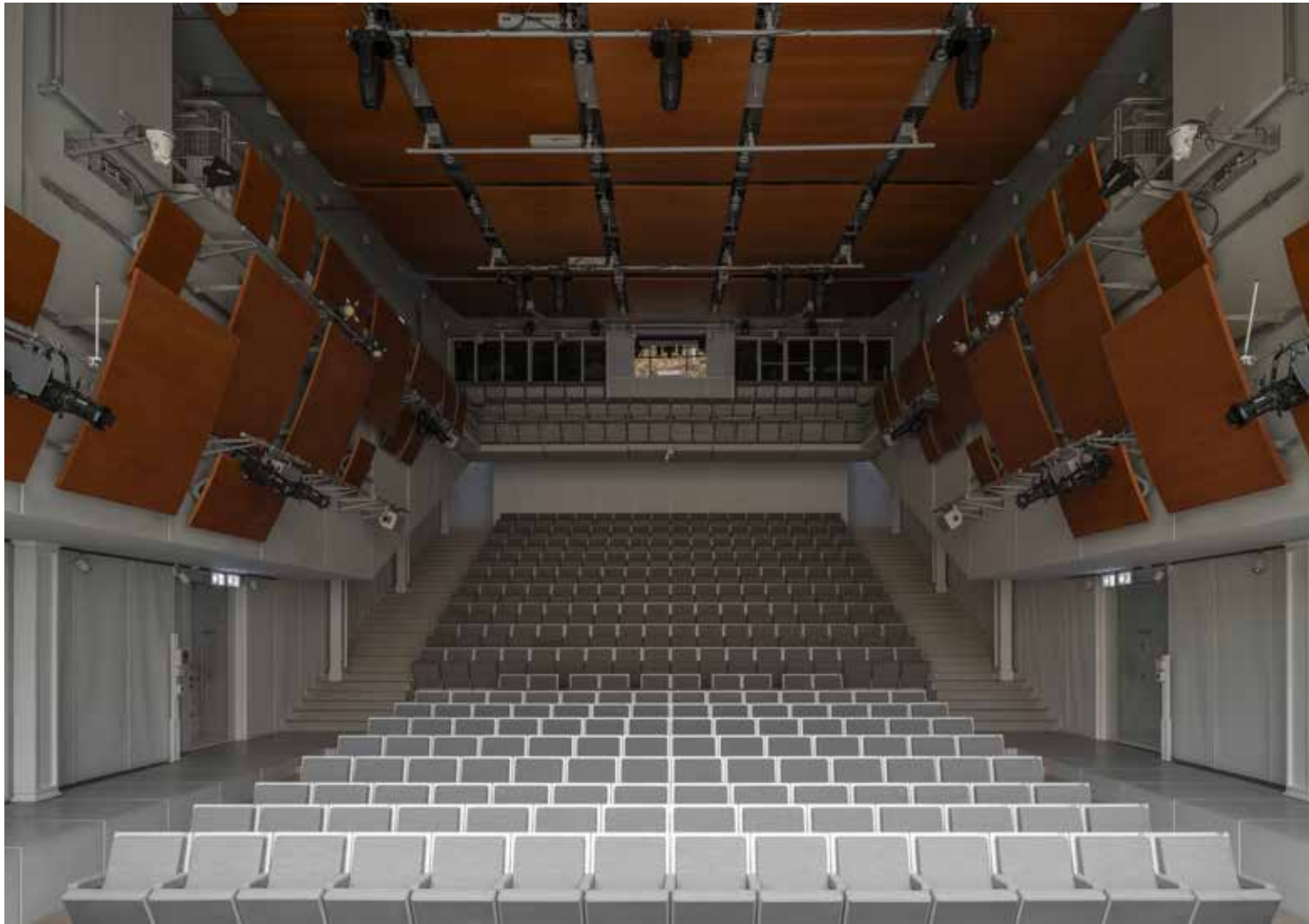

VAC Museum

In 2021, V-A-C Foundation inaugurated an innovative exhibition area located in the former GES-2 power plant, situated on the Bolotnava Embarkment in the centre of Moscow. The renovation project of the early 1900 building, was developed by Renzo Piano Building Workshop. An innovative space where multi-artistic productions can find their ideal location, from art exhibitions, to music, theatre, film screenings and education, facilitating the connection between the arts.





In this scenario Poltrona Frau Custom Interiors business unit was involved in the design and engineering project of a revolutionary seating. The project is based on the well-tested Gala system – a particularly complex mechanism that allows entire seating rows to fold and disappear under the hall's floor, therefore giving maximum flexibility to the environments in terms of seating capacity and floor space.

For this renovation project Poltrona Frau developed the 400 custom-made seats following the design of RPBW; the long and thin metal legs evoke the sense of lightness and transparency of the spaces. In addition, the GALA System obliges to create seats with a reduced weight, specific safety requirements for the users, and dimensions for the motion systems which allow the seat to safely go up and down, rotate and fold.





To stay under the maximum weight allowed - 30kg – Poltrona Frau engineers decided to use steel for the legs and aluminum for the back and seat structure; but also, to remove the steel counterweight usually used for the folding system, therefore they created a new mechanism with torsion springs for the automatic seat return, and a folding armrest. However, the amazing result is not only a highly technological project, but an extremely comfortable and welcoming seat, underlining Poltrona Frau's signature in the seating industry.



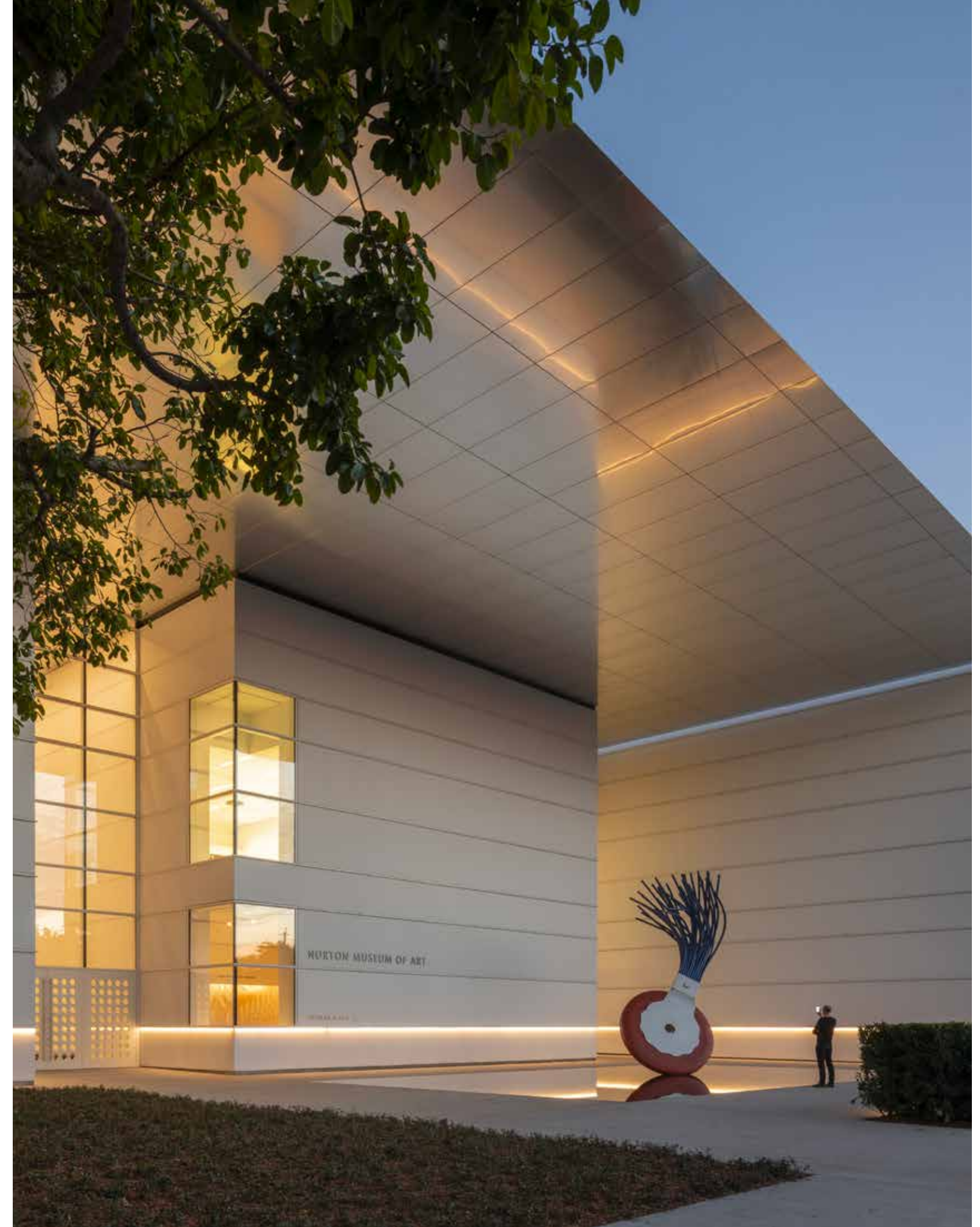

Norton Museum of Art

The Norton Museum of Art was founded in 1941 by Mr. and Mrs. Norton. He was the head of the Acme Steel Company in Chicago, and their art collection started as a private one for their home, becoming in time a truly remarkable selection. Today, the museum consists of a permanent collection of 8,200 art pieces and five departments: European, American, Chinese, Contemporary, and Photography.

In 2019, the London-based architectural firm Foster + Partners was asked to design the new Kenneth C. Griffin Building to provide further gallery space, classrooms and student exhibition areas, an auditorium, a new store, a restaurant, and a Great Hall to the original building.

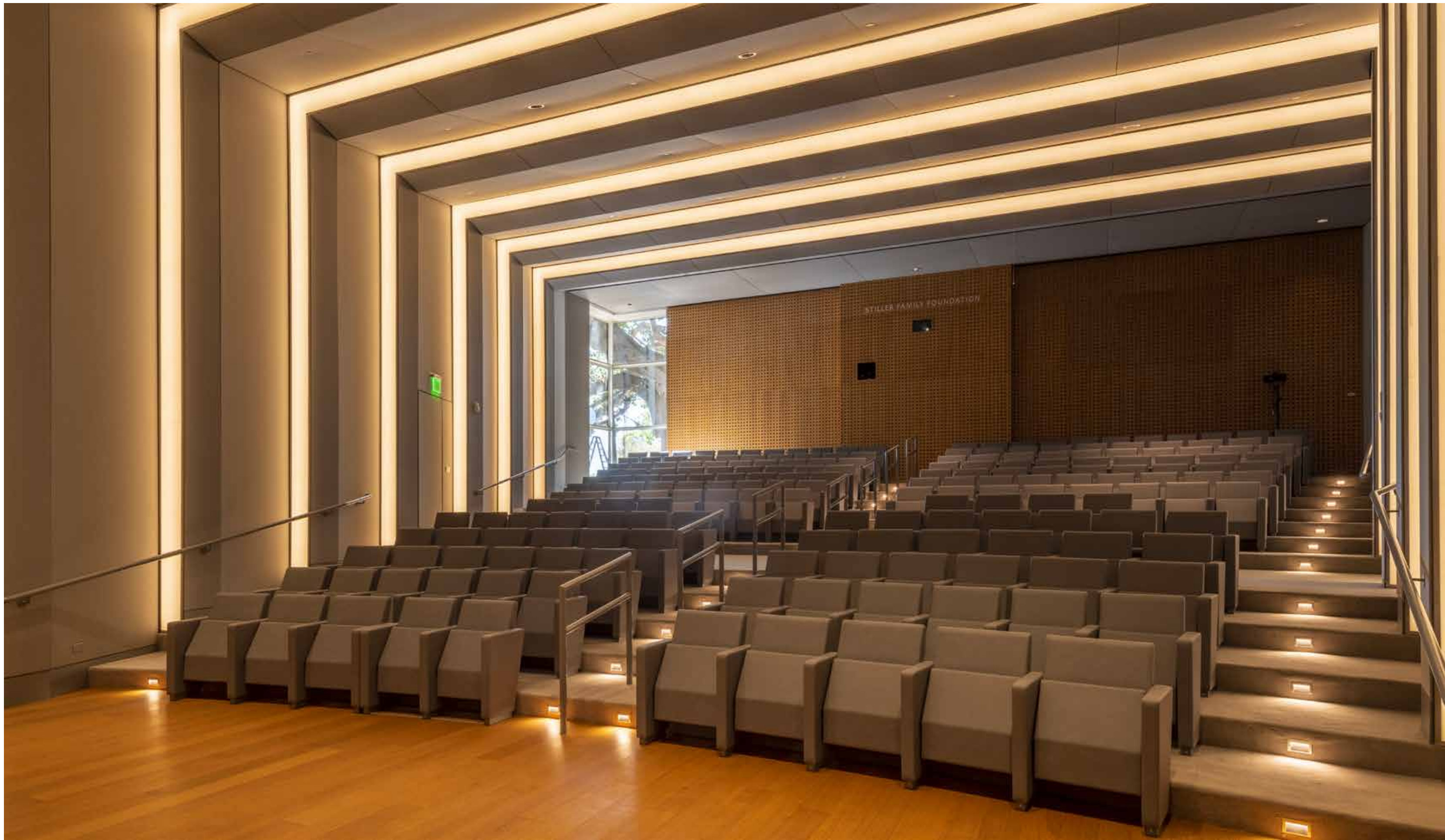




Poltrona Frau Custom Interiors provided 200 Thea seats designed by the same architectural firm, Foster + Partners.

The Thea chair has a solid beech frame; the backrest and seat padding are in non-deforming fire-resistant polyurethane to ensure maximum comfort; the spring system includes elastic belts and automatic tip-up seat thanks to the steel counterweight. For this project, the seats were fully upholstered in faux leather (Skai Palma), with three varying widths for ideal layout and audience sightlines.

Thea has a compact and balanced design, with contained and comfortable volumes, while guaranteeing an ideal ergonomic posture. The Norton Museum of Art, together with Foster + Partners and Poltrona Frau create an amazing trio, where art meets architecture joined by the most beautiful design.



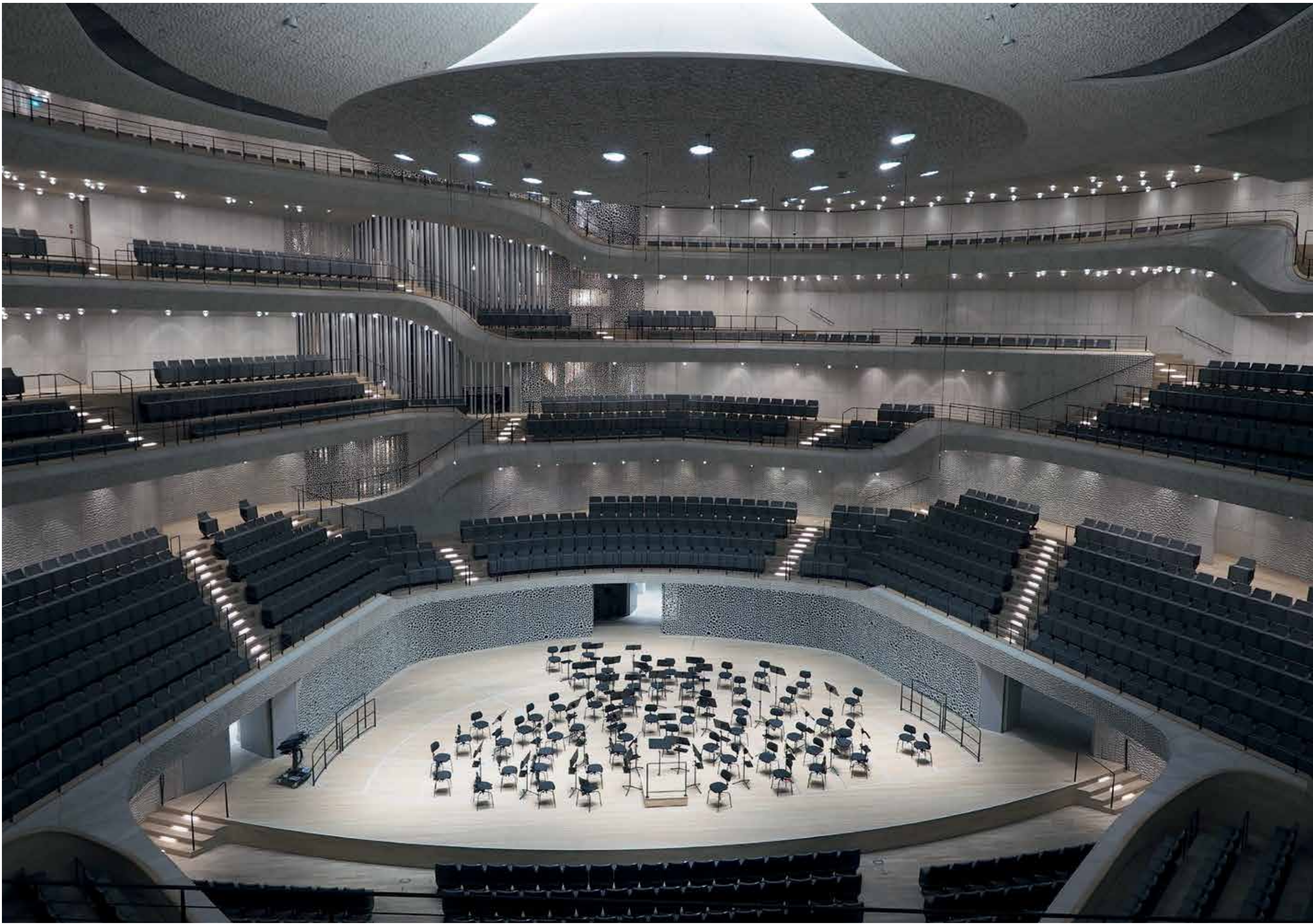

Elbphilharmonie

Designed by Swiss architects Herzog & de Meuron, the Elbphilharmonie in Hamburg was opened in January 2017, becoming the new cultural hub of the city. Herzog & de Meuron, who oversaw every single detail of the project, also studied and developed the design of the chair that furnishes the Grand Hall: the Ham is an inviting, comfortable seat with a dynamic profile. Its supporting structure is made from rigid polyurethane and has an unusual shell shape. Poltrona Frau Custom Interiors supplied and installed 2100 Ham seats for the “Grand Hall” which, designed to hold concerts, represents the centrepiece of the project and is situated at a height of 50 metres above ground level.







The Ham seat and back are in crushproof polyurethane foam offering constant support, for perfect posture during concerts. The back of the seat is unusual, in curved black lacquered wood, a material that helps to achieve the required acoustics.

Poltrona Frau and Nagata Acoustics International have collaborated to achieve optimal acoustic performance. Every single seat at the Elbphilharmonie is positioned at a maximum of 30 metres from the musicians, guaranteeing a remarkably engaging auditory experience.

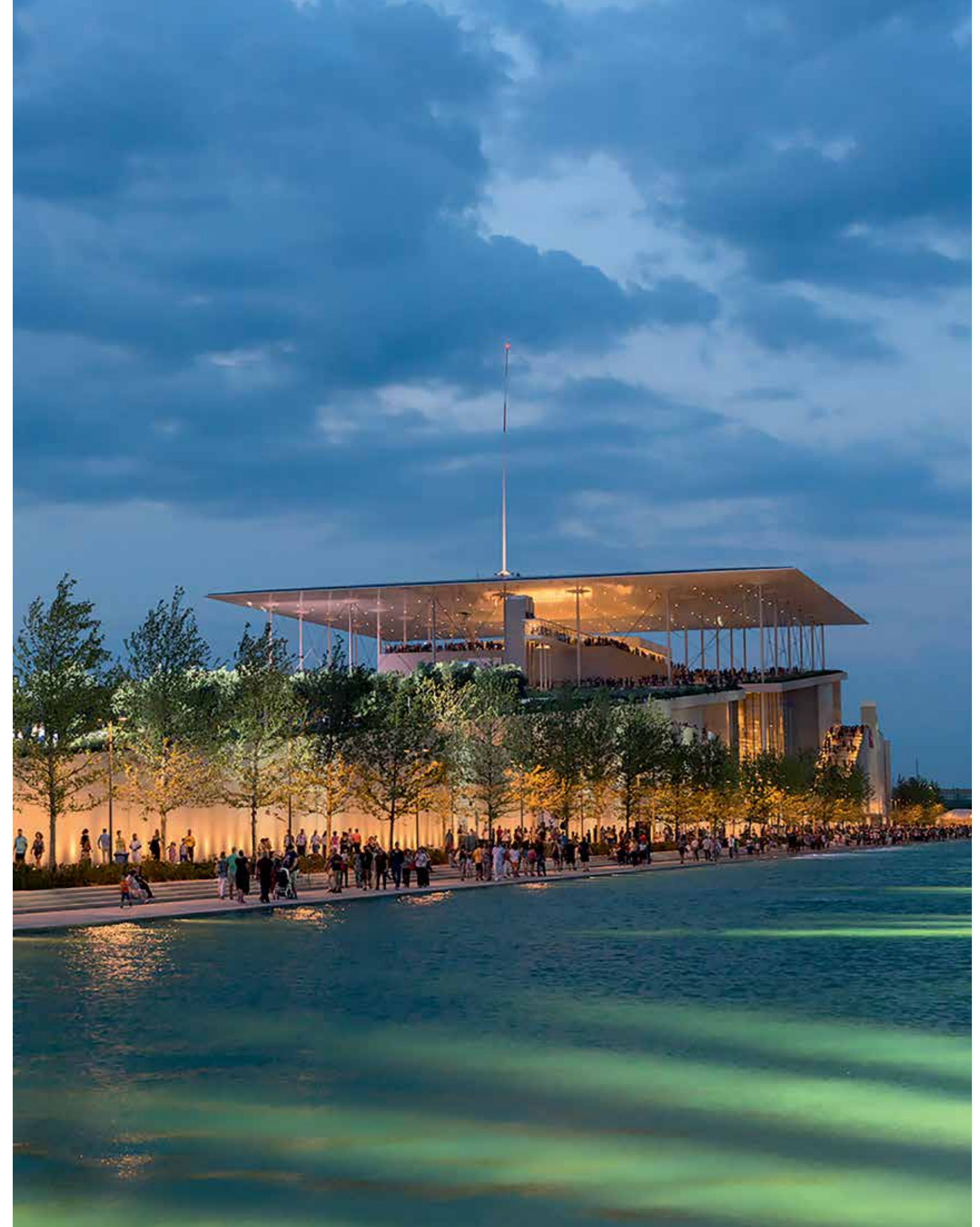

Stavros Niarchos Foundation

The Stavros Niarchos Foundation Cultural Center, the new site of the Greek National Opera, opened to the public in Athens in 2016. The project includes a main theatre with 1400 seats and an experimental theatre with 400 seats; the National Library, with capacity for 2 million books, and a hilltop park of approximately 170,000 m² with 1500 m² of buildings. The auxiliary buildings and the park were designed with an eye on environmental performance and sustainability. Poltrona Frau Custom Interiors supplied the seats for the auditorium, working in close collaboration with the RPBW - Renzo Piano Building Workshop team.

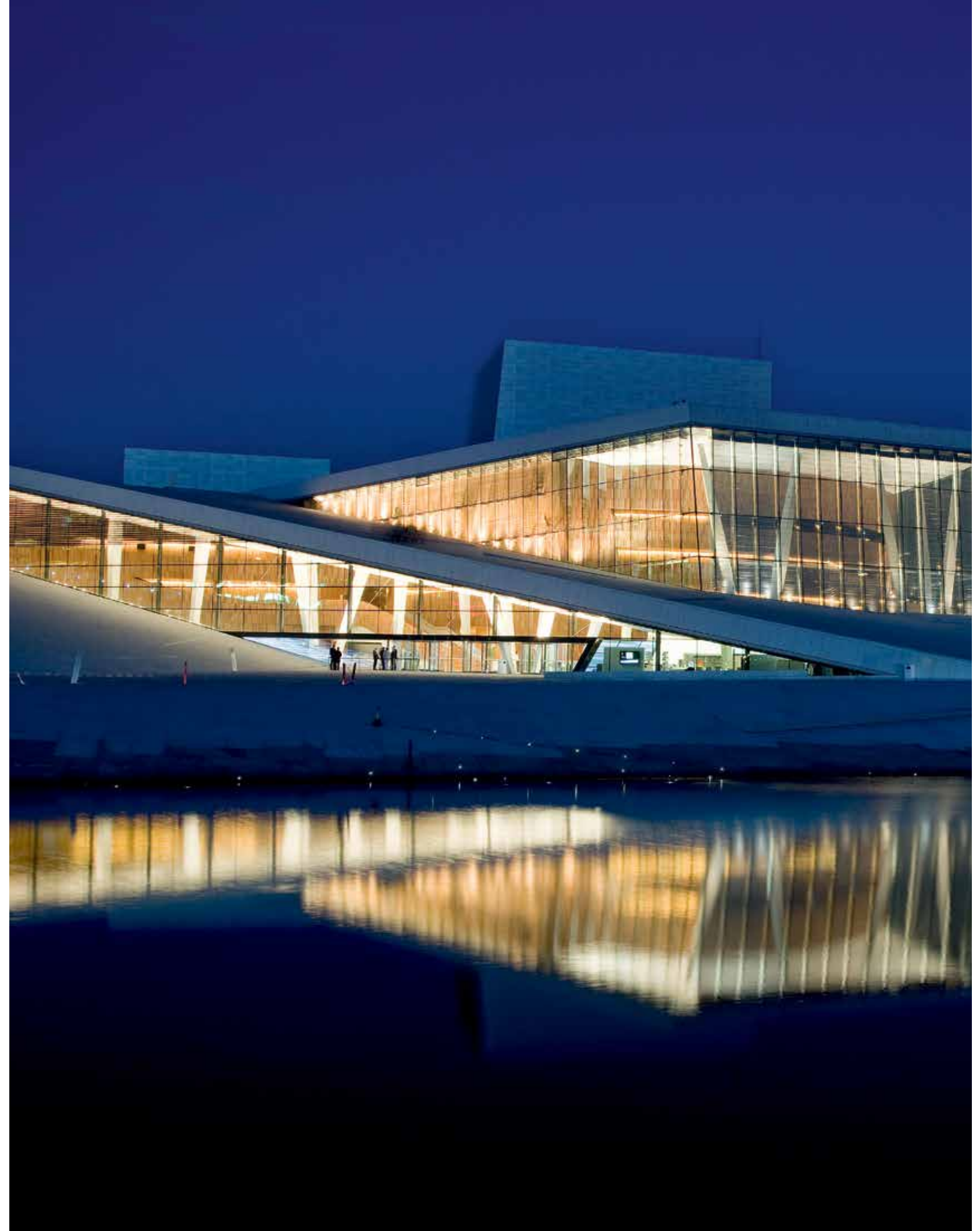

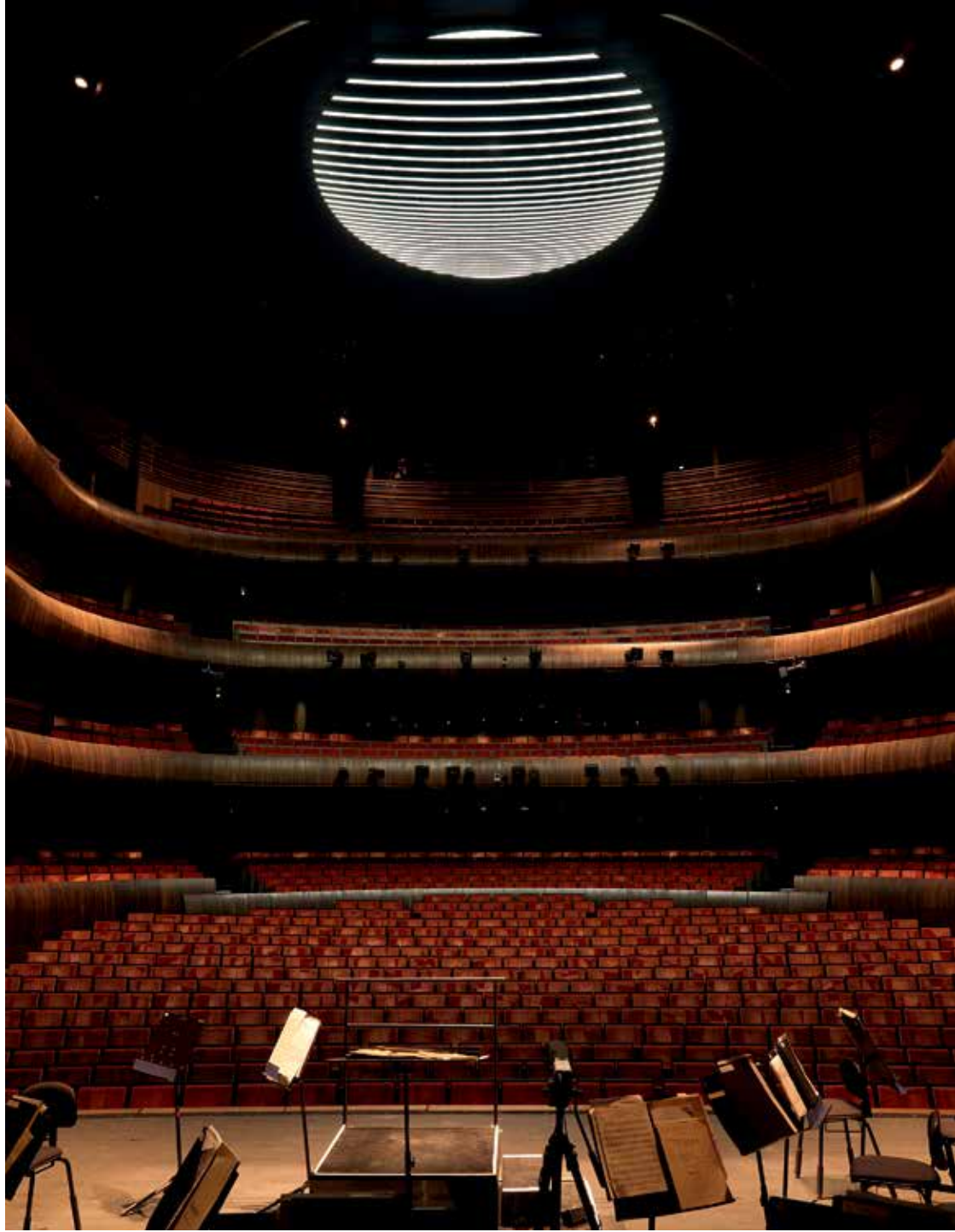

Oslo Opera House

A piece of architecture designed to act as a meeting point between the public and art, and able to welcome up to 1900 spectators, The National Opera House in Oslo, Norway, was designed by architects Snøhetta. Arranged in semicircular rows, the seats are tilted at different angles and have height-adjustable backrests and sides to guarantee maximum comfort and the best possible view and acoustics.

Finnish National Opera House

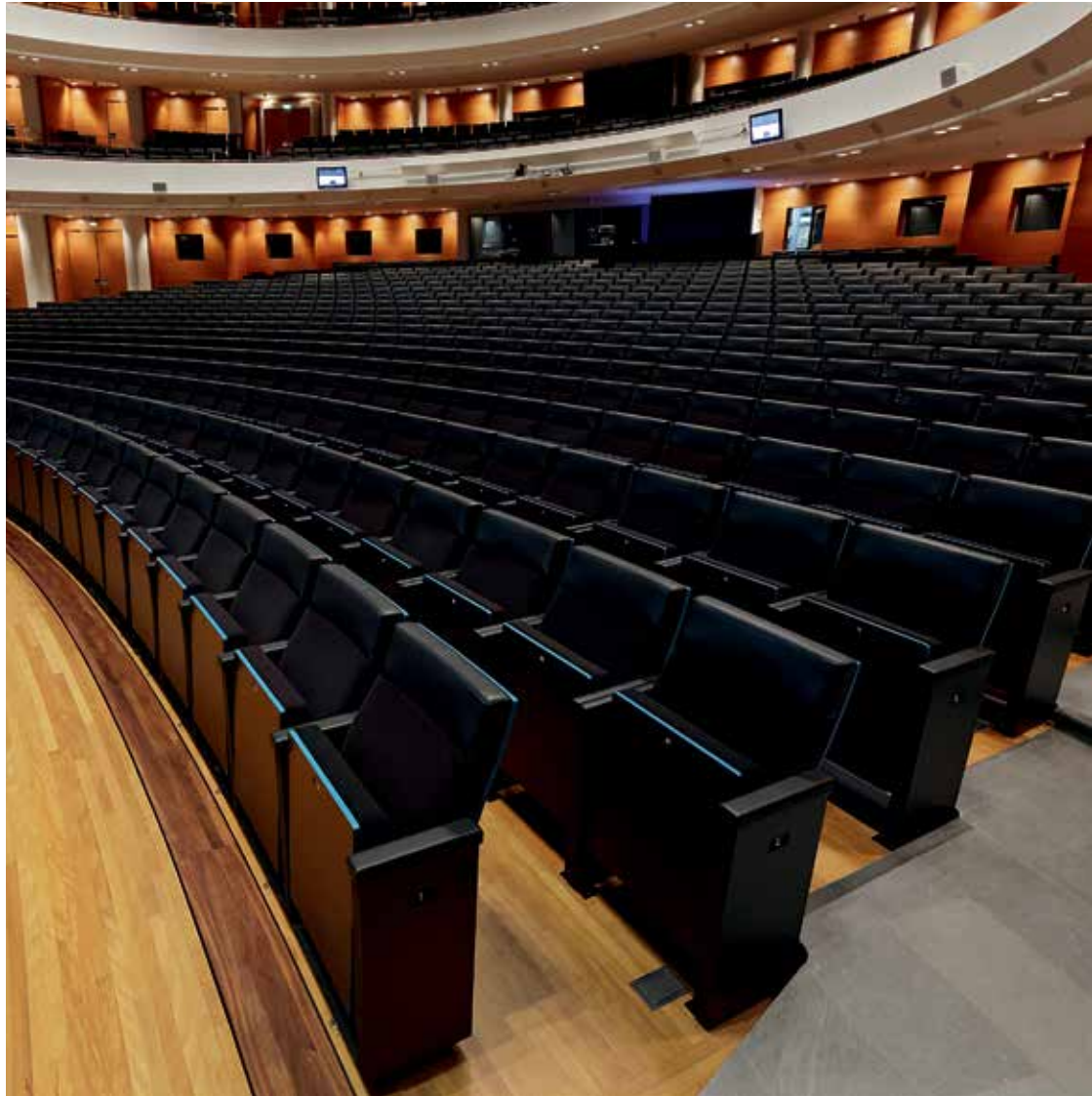

Every year the opera house stages around 20 different operas in 140 performances, and welcomes around 250,000 visitors. The Finnish National Opera House project is the work of architects HKP and designer Neil Morton of Theatre Plan. For its design, they chose to honour the history of the theatre by leaving the atmosphere of the original space intact.

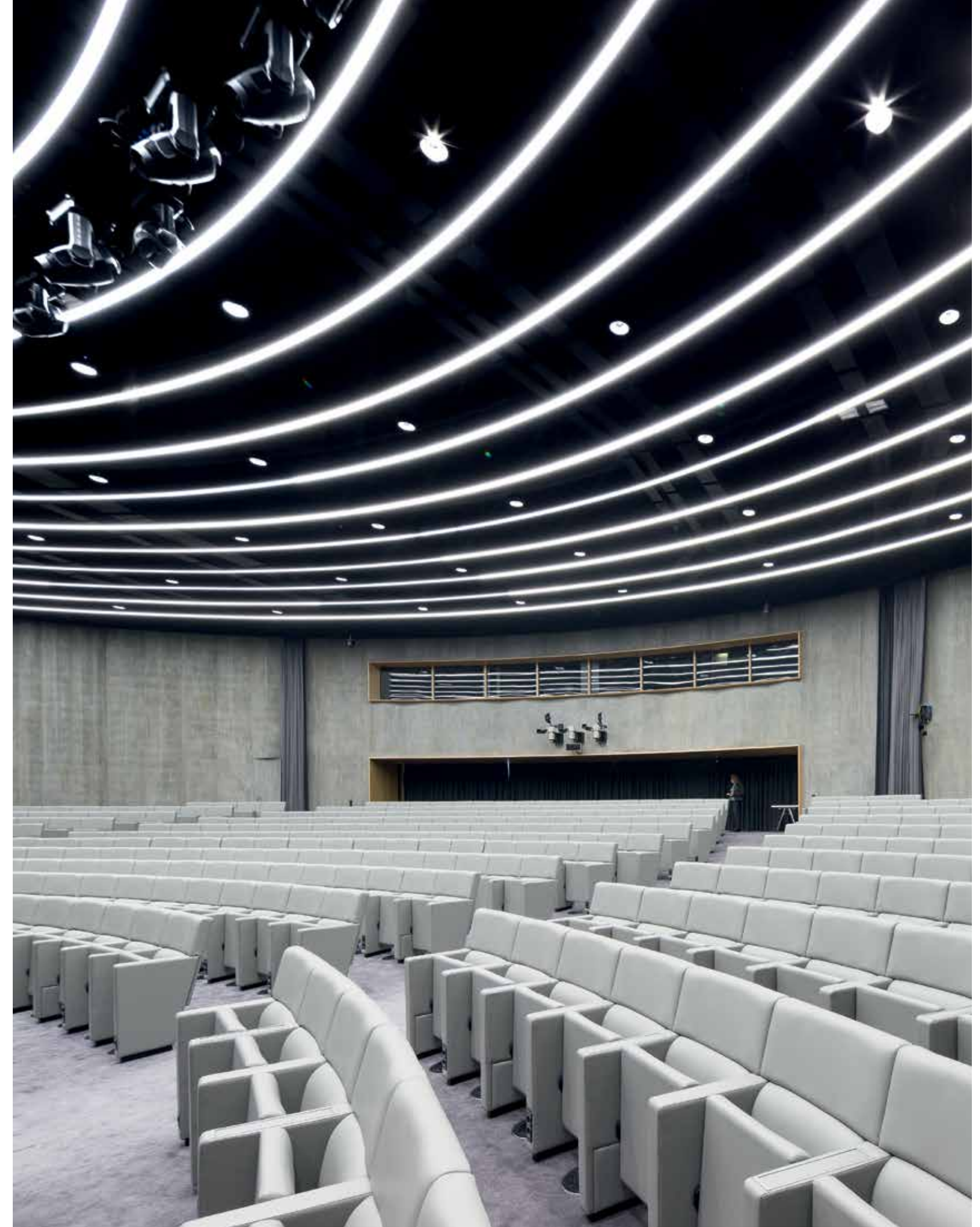

BBVA

BBVA's new corporate headquarters in Madrid are a real architectural and sustainability landmark. The Swiss architecture firm Herzog & de Meuron drew their inspiration from the towns and cities of the past, built for people and their communities. Ciudad BBVA – almost a town of its own in the northern suburbs of Madrid, as the name suggests – gravitates around a large plaza presided by a round-shaped 19 story high rise called La Vela. Seven smaller buildings are built around the plaza and connected by an overhead walkway running along the perimeter. Gardens, patios, canals and cobble stone streets complete the Mediterranean atmosphere of this “town”.



Ciudad BBVA was built following state-of-the-art sustainability criteria, fulfilling even the most demanding international standards for sustainable constructions. In this context, Jacques Herzog and Pierre de Meuron asked Poltrona Frau Custom Interiors to provide 420 Pitagora seats for the auditorium. An imposing, modern construction, dominated by the light shades of grey of the walls and floor carpet, and the white leather of the seats.



Pitagora armchair, designed by Lella and Massimo Vignelli, has a distinctive and rigorous design. Specifically conceived for theatres and auditoriums, it can be installed in a straight line or in curved rows, as in this case. Its contemporary style fits perfectly with the suspended ambience of the location, where the colourless atmosphere gives even more power to the strong personality of this interior design project. For BBVA the Pitagora armchair has been customized with a translation system, it is hidden by a leather-covered flap.

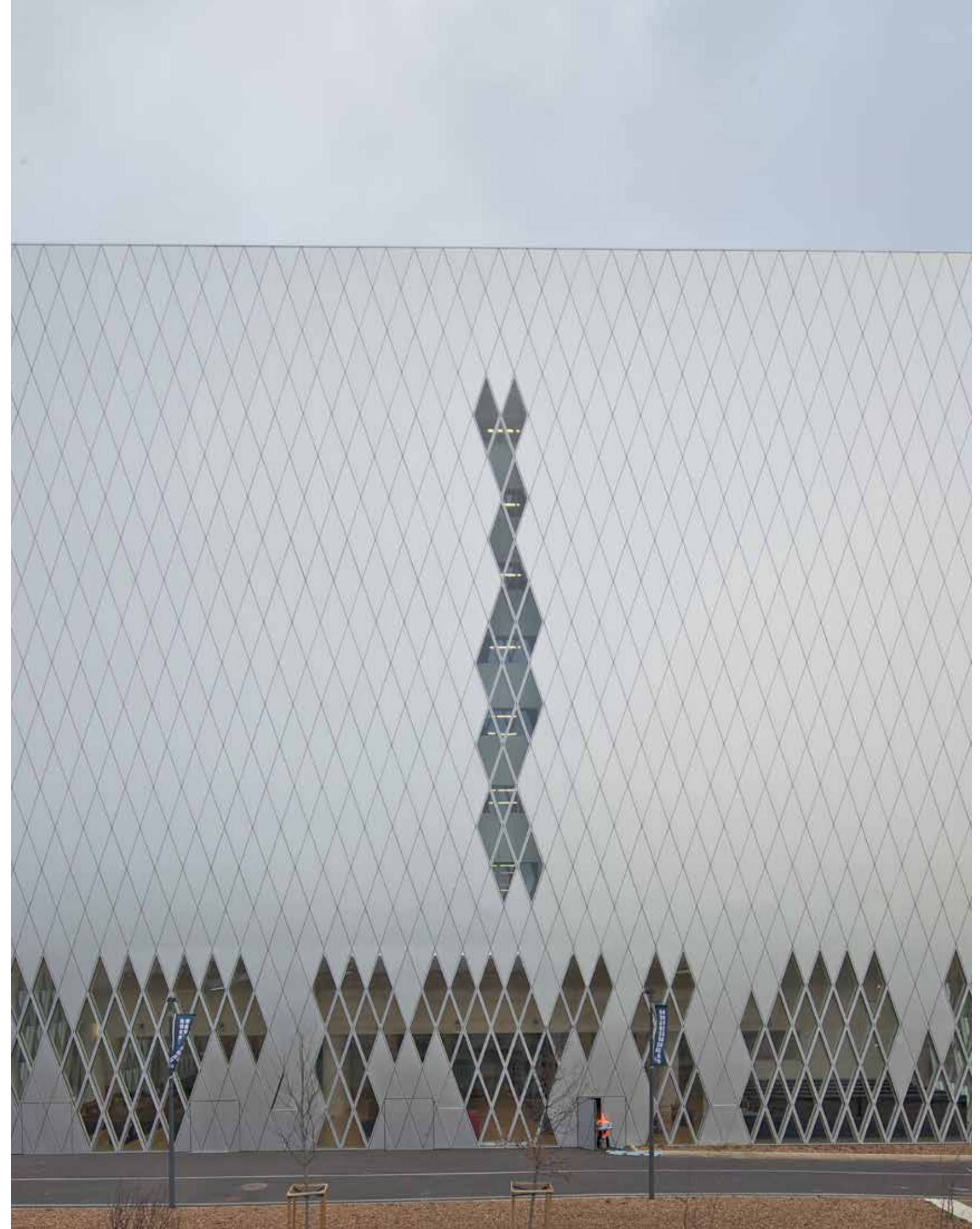

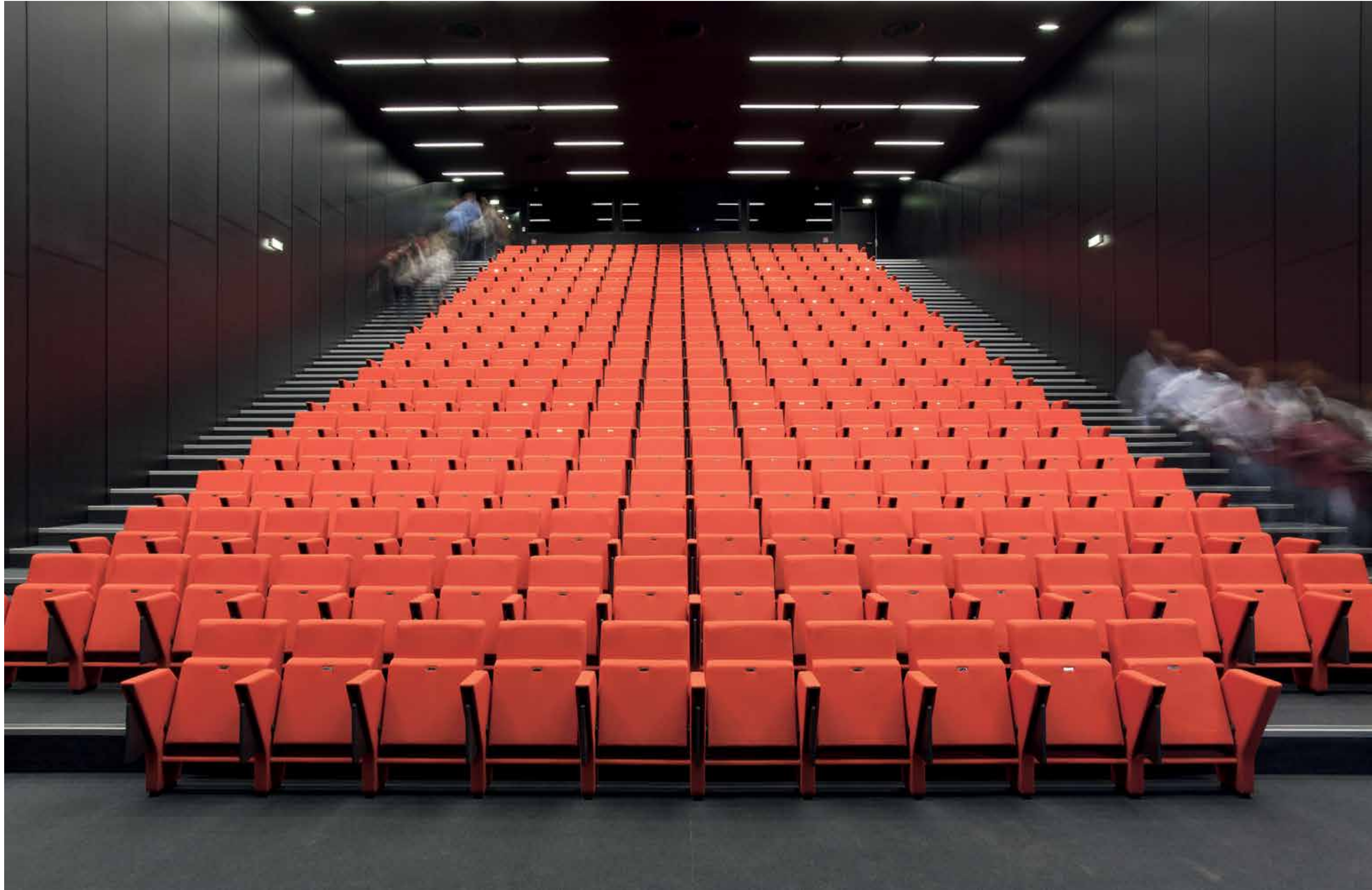

National Archive of France

This impressive building has a surface area of 80,000 m² and 320 km of shelving to house all the historical documents from the French revolution onwards. The conference hall is in one of the six satellite units comprising the building along with the central body.

Poltrona Frau Custom Interiors division team took more than six months to develop the prototype 'Carla' seat which was designed and manufactured for the 300-seater conference hall in the splendid new French national archives.

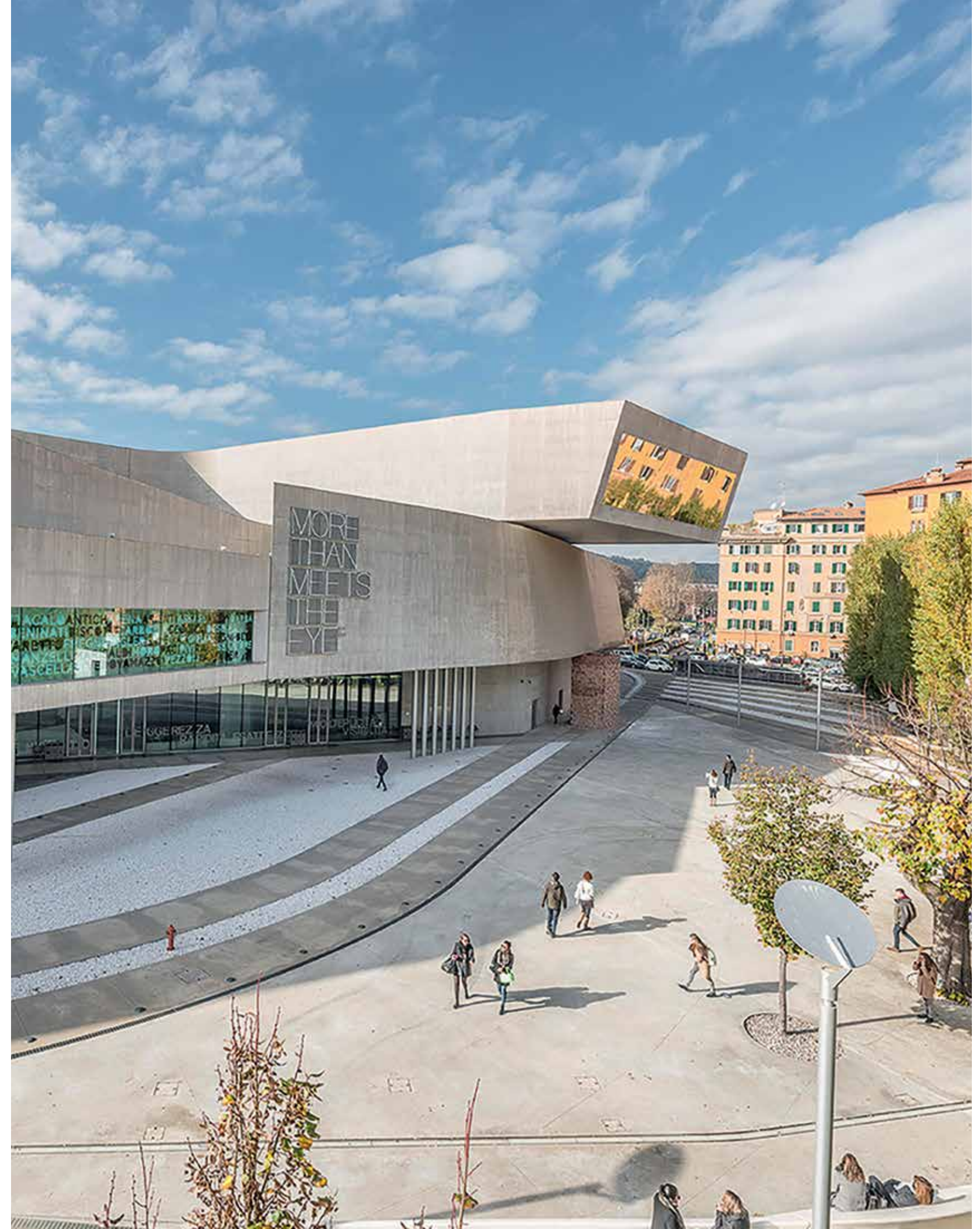
The seat for the conference room, realized in red colour textile, was designed by Fuksas architects. The chair is formed of two planes that intersect and rotate their way into the back, chair and armrests, just like a flower. A measured, minimalist shape.

MAXXI

In summer 2020, during their closing period, which lasted a little more than a month due to the pandemic, Poltrona Frau was called for a challenging mission: renovate the entire seating of the Auditorium of MAXXI, the National Museum of 21st Century Arts of Rome. A turnkey project, where in addition to the new seating, Poltrona Frau Custom Interiors took care of all the dismounting and new installation of the 216 Kube seats, designed in cooperation with studio EOOS. Kube seats are specifically created for auditoriums. They have a peculiar suspended shape.



When closed, the single seat merges into a linear and compact module, creating the feeling of the ancient amphitheaters. For its elegance and style, Kube was awarded the prestigious Compasso d'Oro ADI in 2004. Kube seating has a metal and wood structure, a comfortable polyurethane padding and for this occasion, Pelle Frau® upholstery. In addition, each seat is personalized with the museum's logo.



Kube seating has a metal and wood structure, a comfortable polyurethane padding and for this occasion, Pelle Frau® upholstery. In addition, each seat is personalized with the museum's logo. MAXXI was conceived as a broad cultural campus, hosting exhibitions, workshops, conferences, shows, projections and educational projects, in this context the Auditorium becomes a very important location for most of the museum's activities. MAXXI was built in 2003 and designed by the famous Anglo-Iraqi architect Zaha Hadid.



Its innovative architectural design becomes a new and immersive experience. Poltrona Frau perfectly embodies the spirit of the project with its contemporary urban style, a challenging mission where manufacturing and logistics come together for the most successful result.



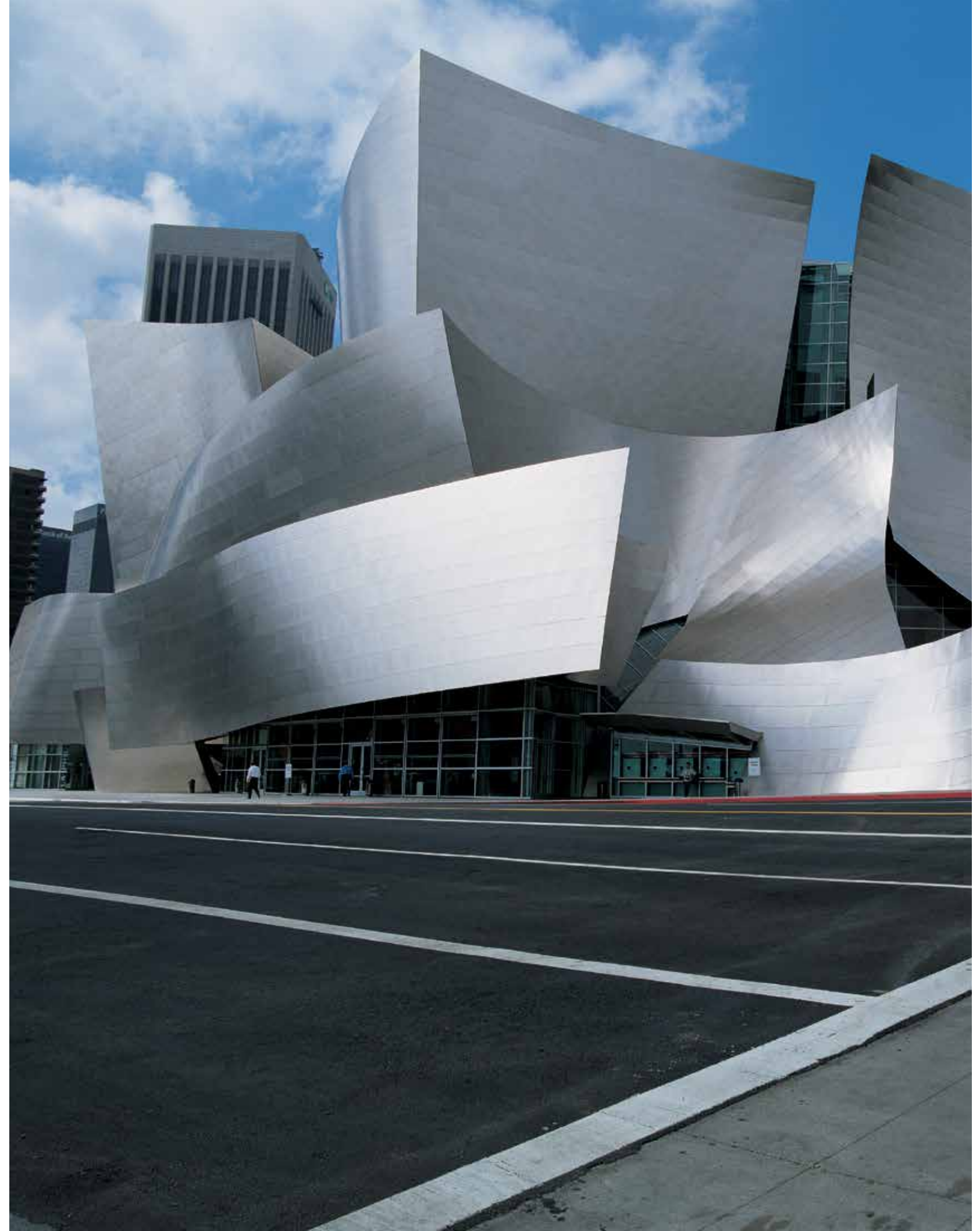

The Walt Disney Concert Hall in Los Angeles, California is the fourth Music Center hall in Los Angeles. It has a capacity of 2265 people and is also home to the Philharmonic Orchestra and Master Chorale of Los Angeles.

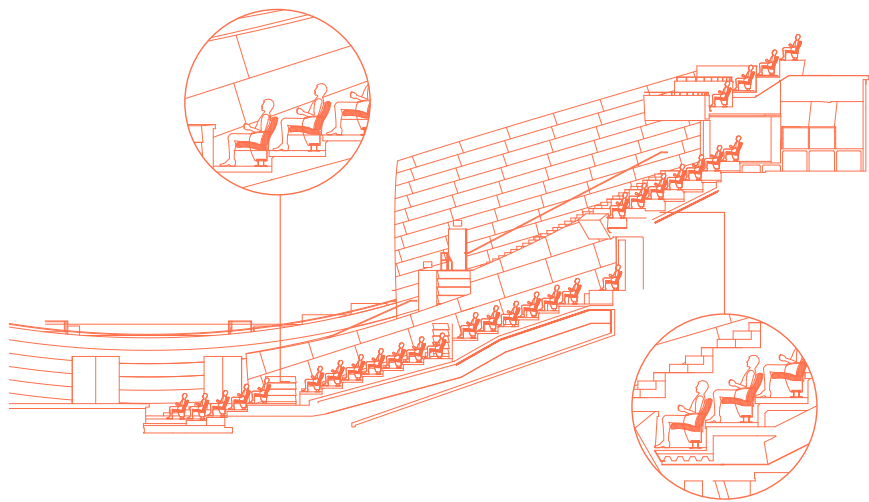

The seats are crafted from steel, wood, polyurethane and fabric, combined in such a way as to comply with acoustic standards.

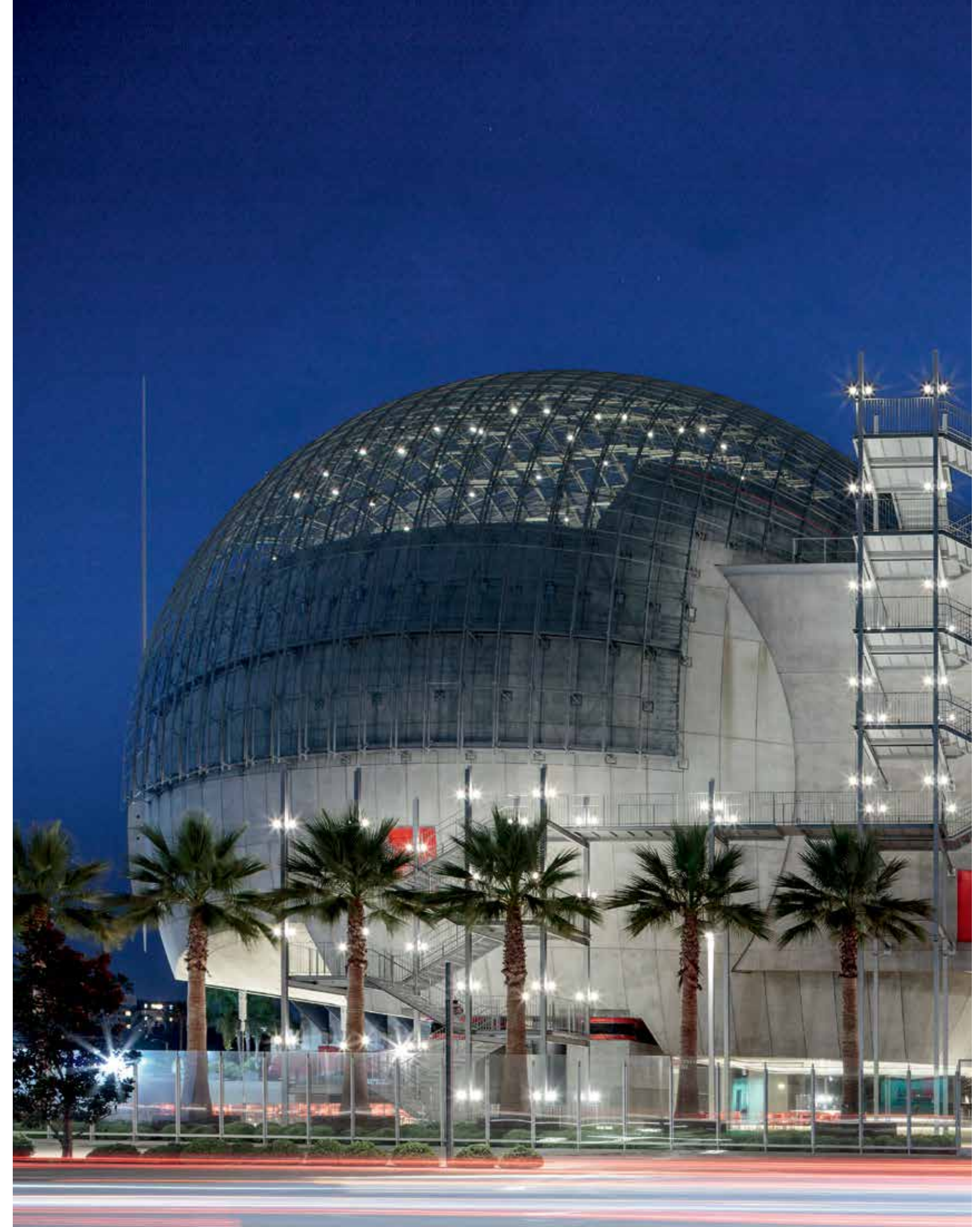

AMMP

The Academy Museum of Motion Pictures of Los Angeles, the movie capital of the world, is the first institution dedicated to the arts and science of motion pictures. Designed by the world-famous architect Renzo Piano, the museum comprises of two buildings, the historical May Company building and the new glass and concrete Sphere Building. 30.000 square meters dedicated to permanent and temporary exhibitions, educational spaces, events locations, and of course the amazing state-of-the-art David Geffen Theatre and Dolby Family Terrace, an open-air promenade facing over the city, Hollywood Hills and the iconic Hollywood Sign.



Poltrona Frau, with its Custom Interiors division, developed the project for the 1000 seats of the Geffen Theatre, in cooperation with the seating designers of RPBW. A two-year challenging team-work that brought to the creation of custom-made seats, specifically designed for the occasion, completely tailor-made to suit the needs and requirements of this location.

The Geffen Theatre's stage can accommodate a 60-piece orchestra, while the seats in the front rows can be removed to create room for catwalks or other types of events. Also, the red velvet upholstery was specifically created to reflect the requests of RPBW designers.



In this case, as for many other projects, Poltrona Frau Custom Interiors division supported the work of the designers with their long-time experience and creative talent, faithfully respecting and interpreting their ideas while carrying out all the creative and manufacturing phases, from the first planning stage, through the development of the ideas, to their final implementation.



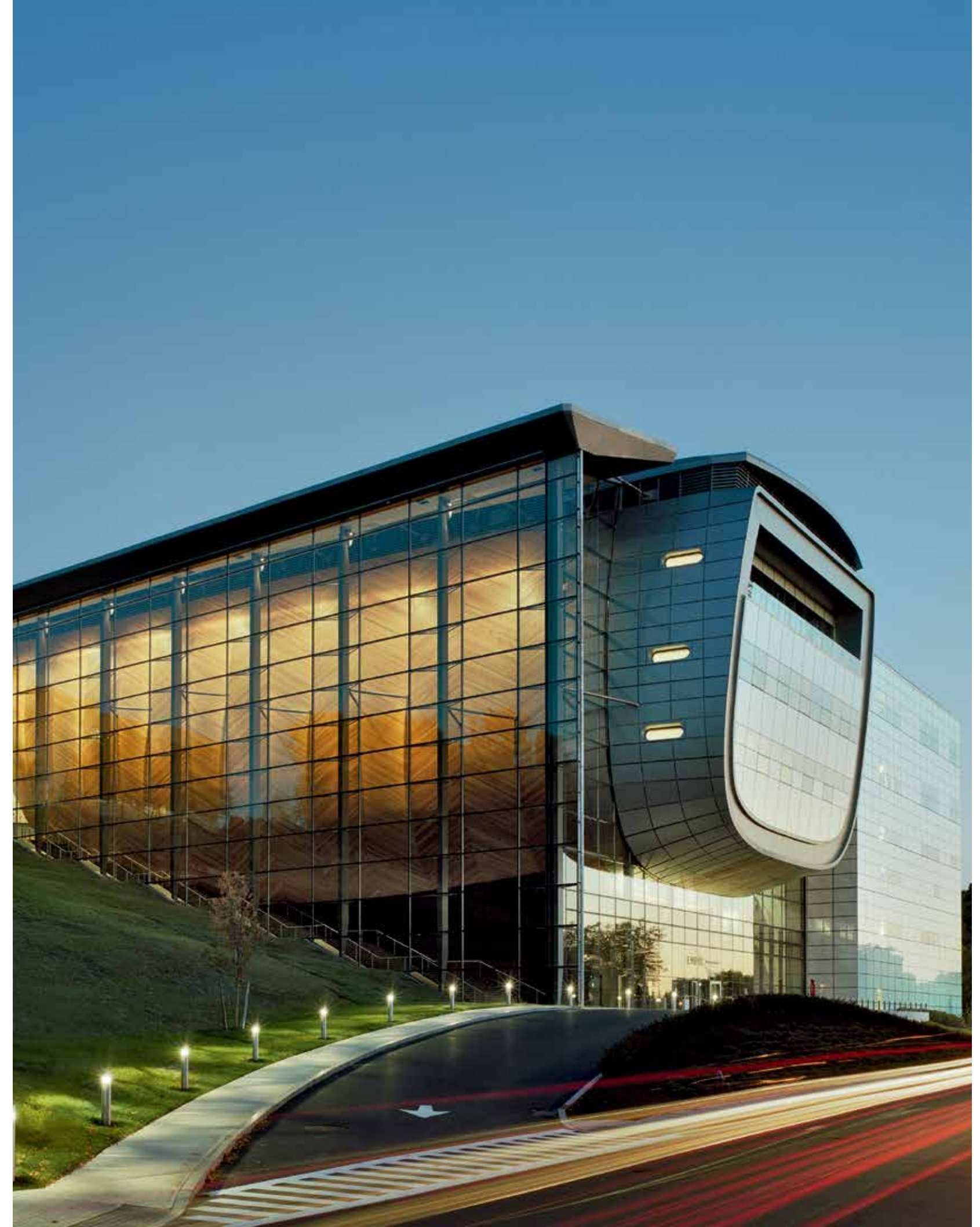

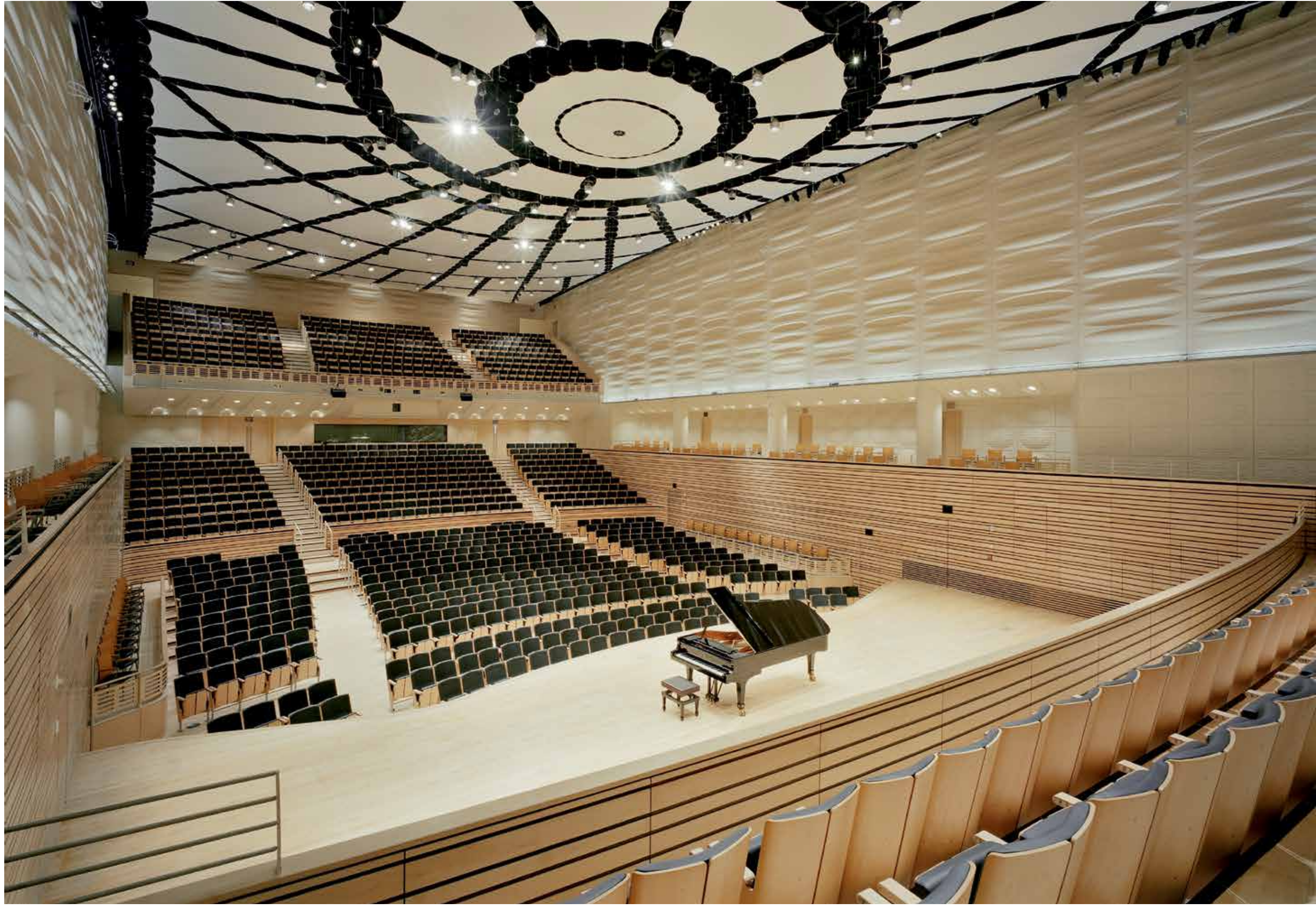

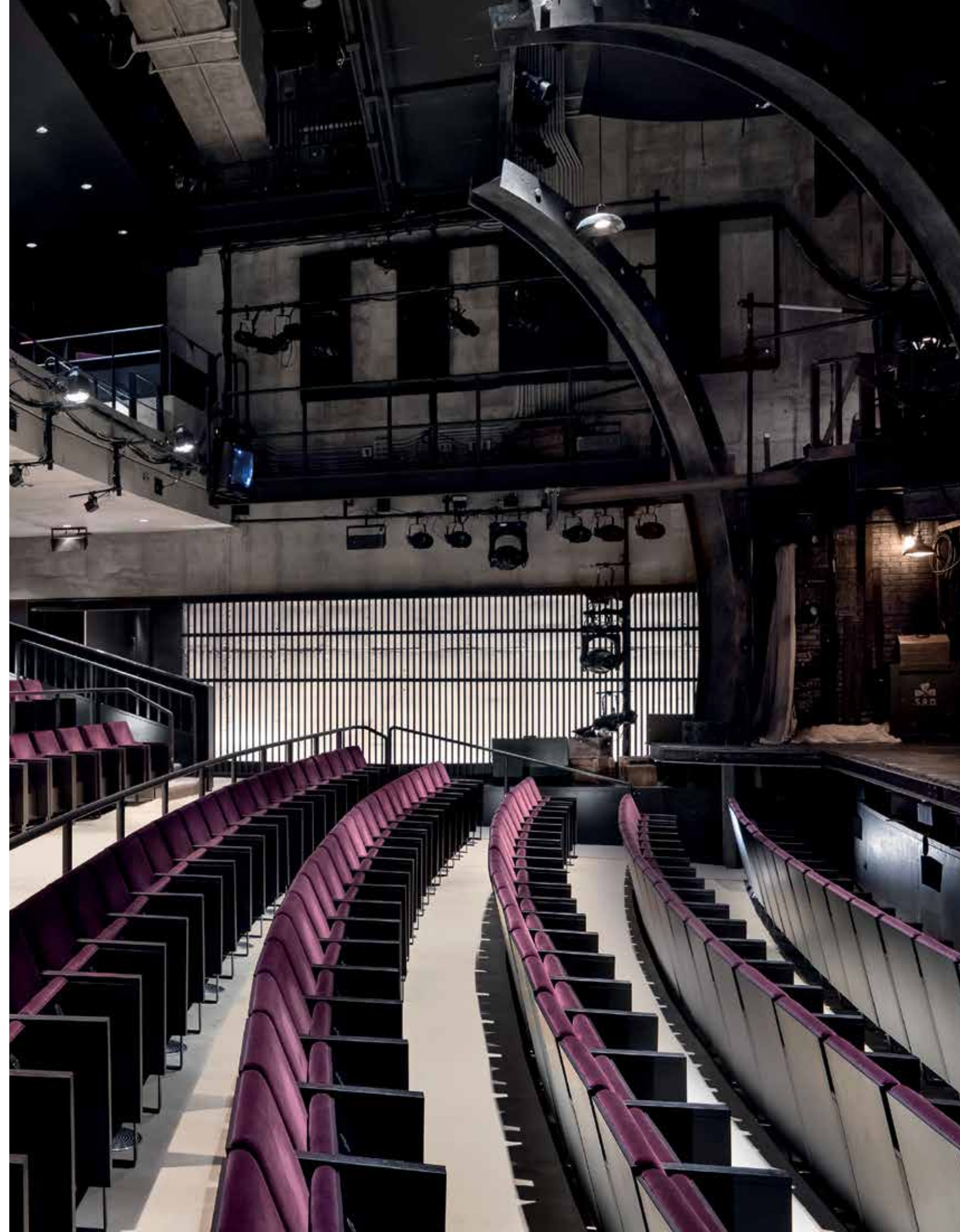

Wilson MCC Theater Space continues today to be a creative hotbed. This new space is a state-of-the-art structure, shaped on the needs of the artists. And who better than Poltrona Frau could interpret the desires of its architect Andrew Berman? In this case, the project had several fundraising steps, but the common objective was only one: finalizing the new theatre and help young actors and performers bring on stage their talent. The original design by Foster + Partners is upholstered in dark burgundy Maharam mohair with wooden finishes on the seats, backrests and side panels. In addition, the armrests are made in solid wood, which confers a modern but stylish look to the final product. Thea chair has a compact and rational design, combined with contained and comfortable volumes. It guarantees an ergonomically correct posture, the perfect start for enjoying a wonderful theatre season.

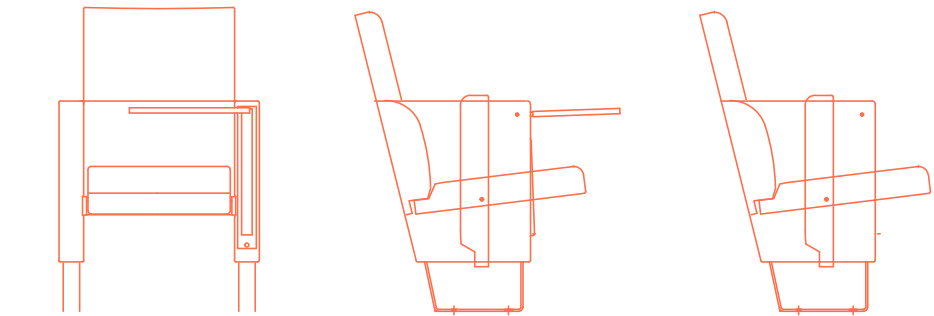
The Jockey Club Innovation Tower

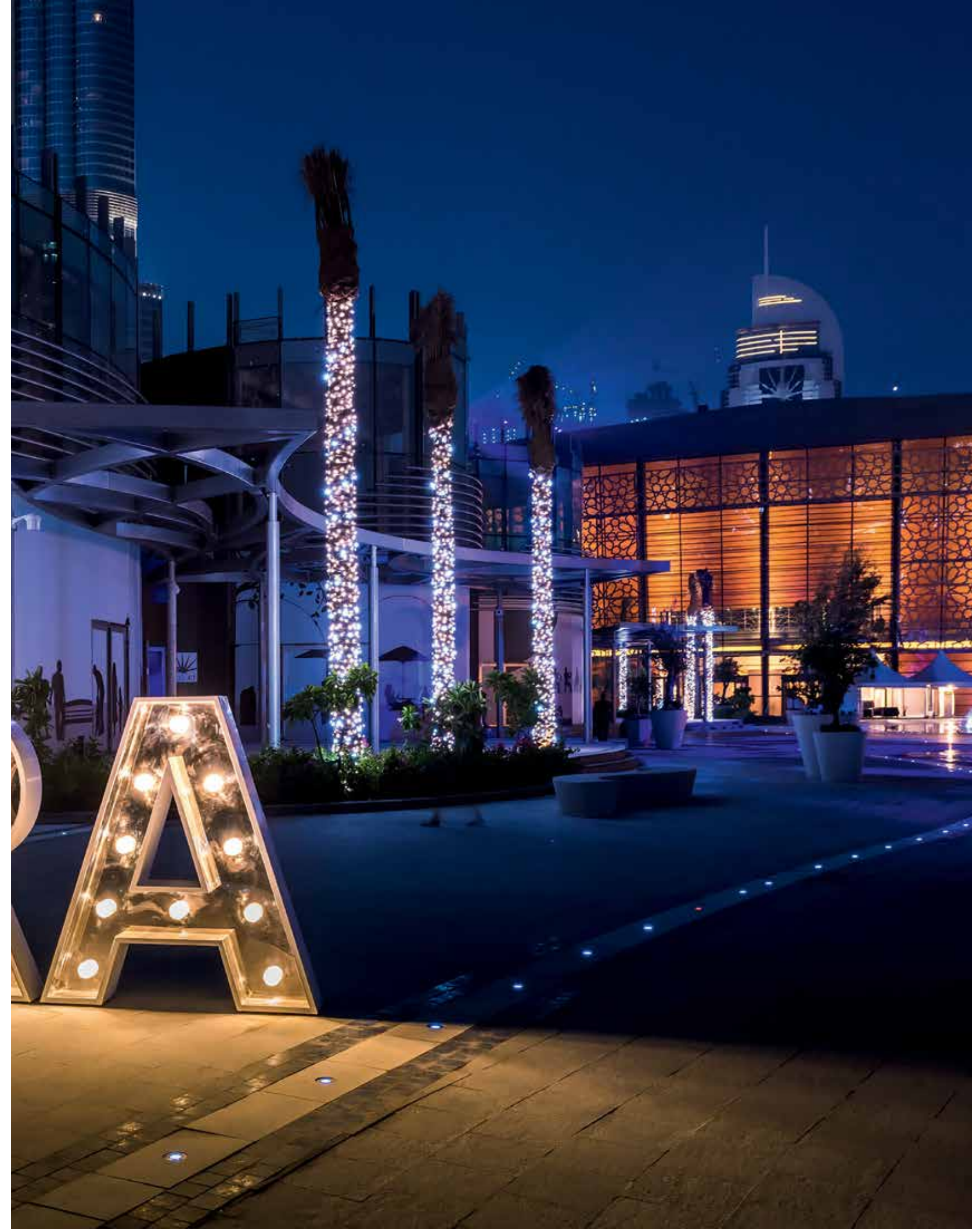

Designed by Danish architect Janus Rostock of Atkins, the Opera House is the first multifunctional theatre in Dubai, a versatile location that can be transformed from a classic theatre into a concert hall, a venue for art exhibitions or fashion shows, or even an events room for large banquets. 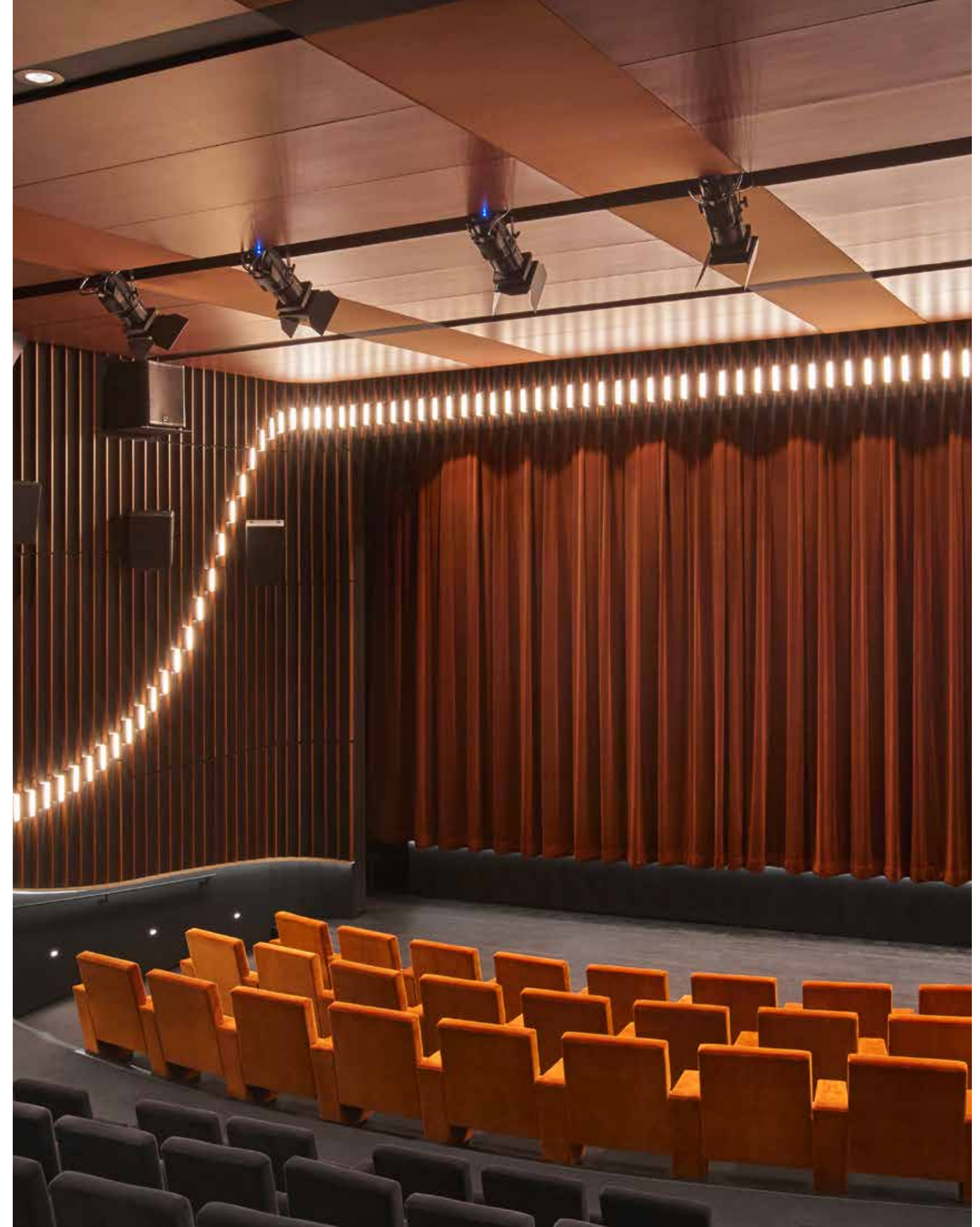

MPA

The Motion Picture Association supports the work and business of the film, television, and streaming industry around the world. Its headquarters, a brutalist building of the 1950's located in Washington DC, underwent renovation in 2020 with Gensler architectural studio.

Gensler transformed the association into an entertainment hub, a perfect blend between the glamorous style of old Hollywood and contemporary technological innovation. The project included the reception area, theater, and hospitality zone.







The theater consists of a 145-foot curved metal wall in champagne color, with milled metal fins that lift like a modern theatre curtain, revealing a curved digital screen. The lines are inspired by the fluid and sinuous shape of old film reels, ready to welcome the elite and celebrities of Hollywood and Washington DC.

Poltrona Frau Custom Interiors provided the seating for the screening theatre. The first three rows include twenty-four XL VIP Pitagora C-C 33 ½” with a 16-degree back tilt mechanism. The seats are fully upholstered in HBF Velvet in Raw Sienna, with extra-thick seats and backrests for added comfort. The rear block of the theater has eighty-eight Pitagora C-C 23” with a 10-degree back tilt mechanism, fully upholstered in Athens/Aria velvet by Schellens in black.

Poltrona Frau Custom Interiors is the perfect partner for every seating project. Their widespread knowledge in terms of quality, technical support, and safety regulations guarantee maximum comfort, enjoyment, and undeniably, beautiful design.

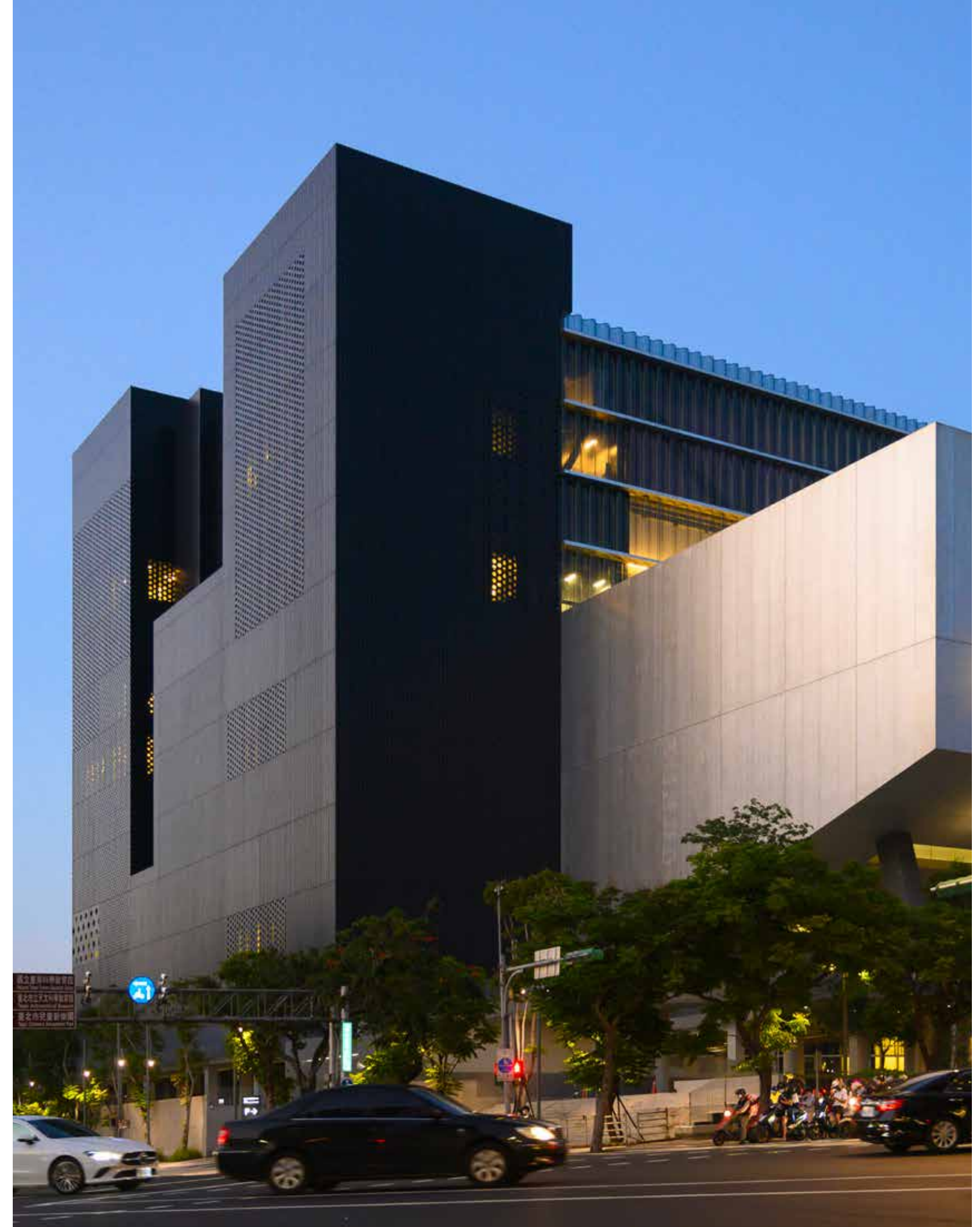

Taipei Performing Art Center

The Taipei Performing Arts Center, designed by OMA, interprets the concept of sustainability with a precise mission of inclusivity. Located in Shilin Night Market, a popular and vibrant area of Taipei, it integrates street life into the theatre. It is an innovative and extremely flexible building, both in the concept as in the shape.

It's made by a spherical Globe Playhouse with a capacity of 800 seats; 1500-seat Great Theatre; and a Blue Box seating 800 people in the central cube.



The last two can be matched together forming a Super Theatre, an amazing space for equally inspiring performances; while the Globe Playhouse is dedicated to experimental theatre, where artists have the opportunity to enhance their talents.

The entire structure is lifted from the ground, almost as floating in the air. The public—with or without a ticket—can enjoy the performances through a Public Loop, which runs through the theater’s infrastructure.

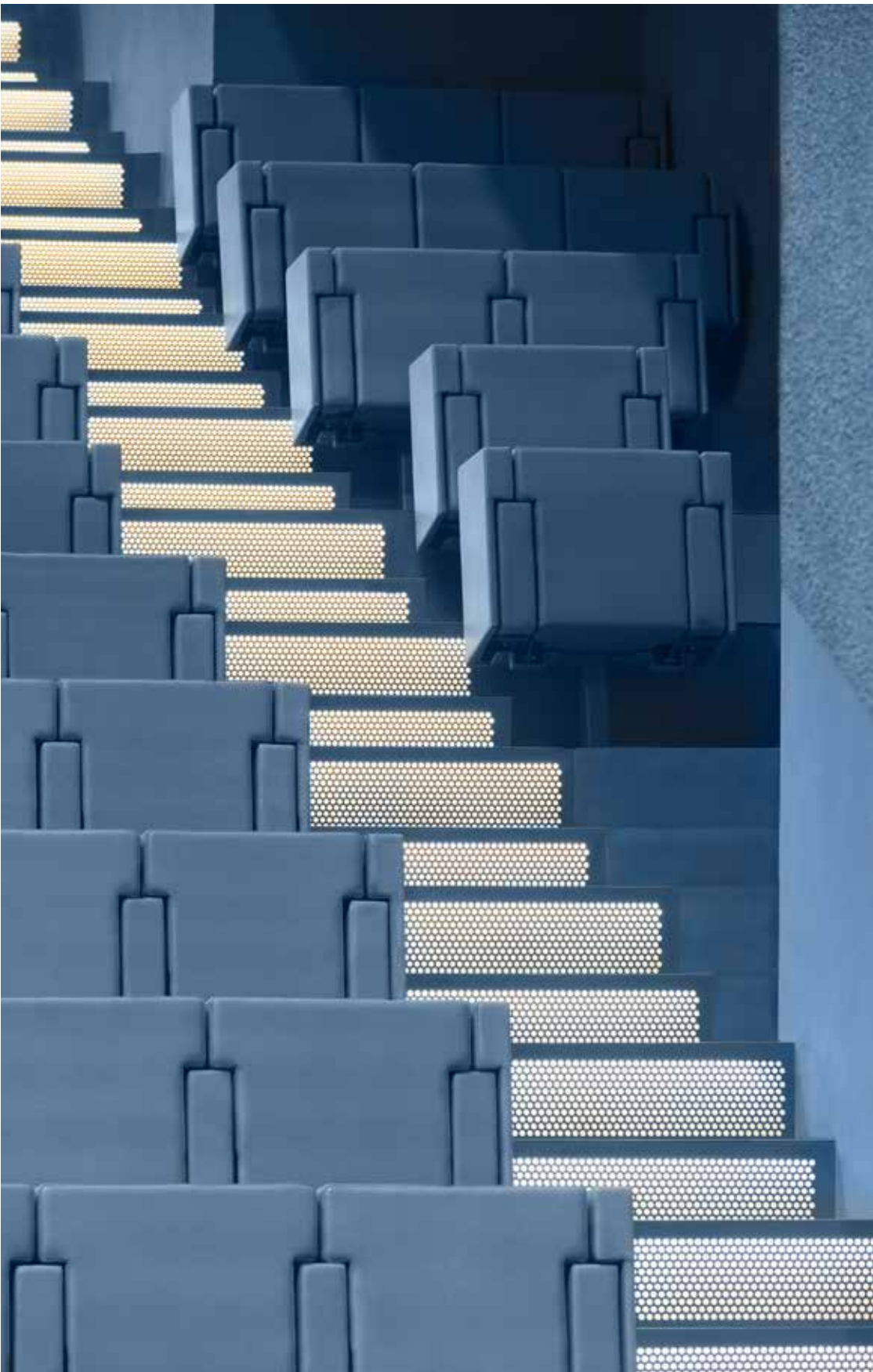
Thanks to its widespread experience in theatre and auditorium seating, Poltrona Frau was called to design the over 3000 seats of the three theatres.

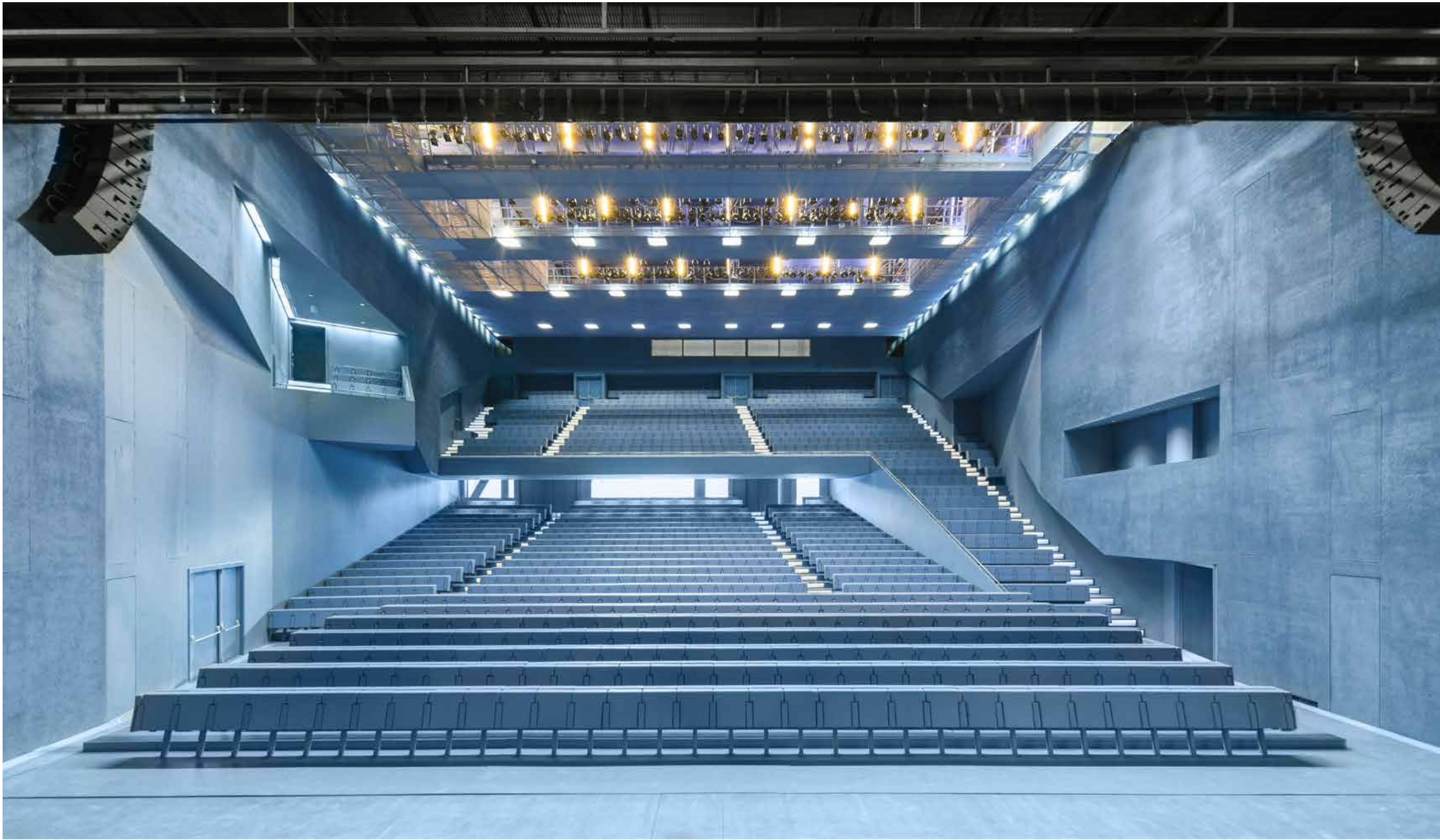

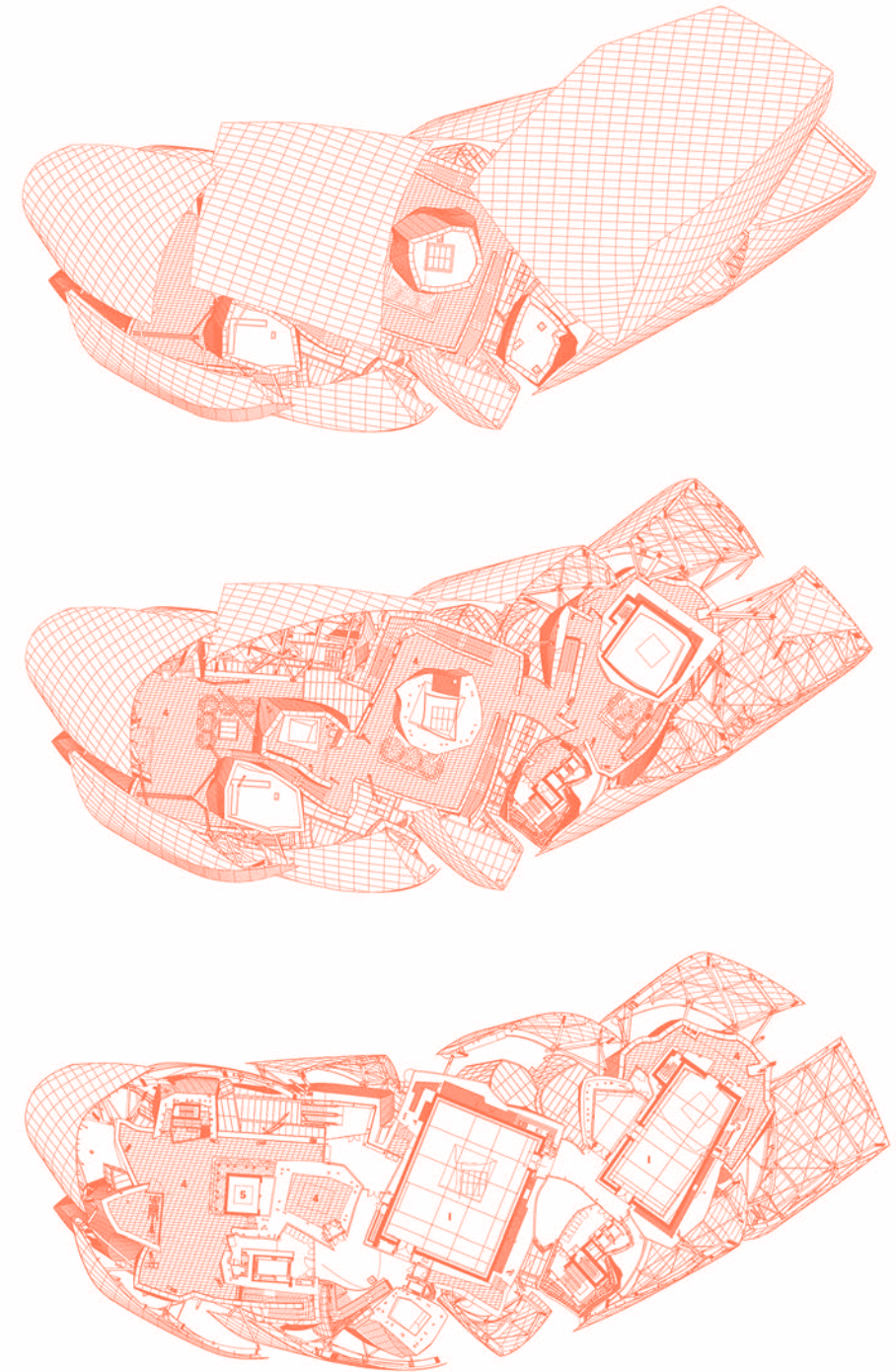
Poltrona Frau Custom Interiors and Frank Gehry worked together on the project to furnish the Louis Vuitton Foundation in Paris, a multipurpose creative space that hosts temporary exhibitions, galleries and permanent collections. The main auditorium, equipped with 340 custom seats supplied by Poltrona Frau, is used for a wide range of events and shows. The installed seats stand out for their unusual sides in steel sheet; the back of the backrest is in visible wood while the armrests are made from curved plywood.



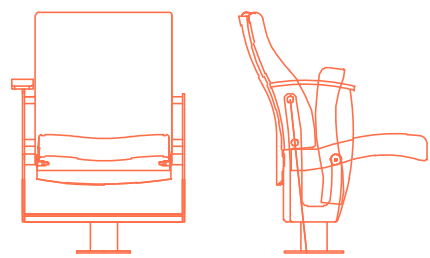


The armchair stands for a perfect synthesis between avant-garde and innovation combined with the original forms and it is well integrated with the futuristic context of the Foundation.

The automatic folding seats have joints in anti-noise nylon while the springs are obtained using a special elastic sheet. The chair is the perfect blend of cutting-edge style, innovation and original design and fits perfectly with the Foundation's futuristic vibe.



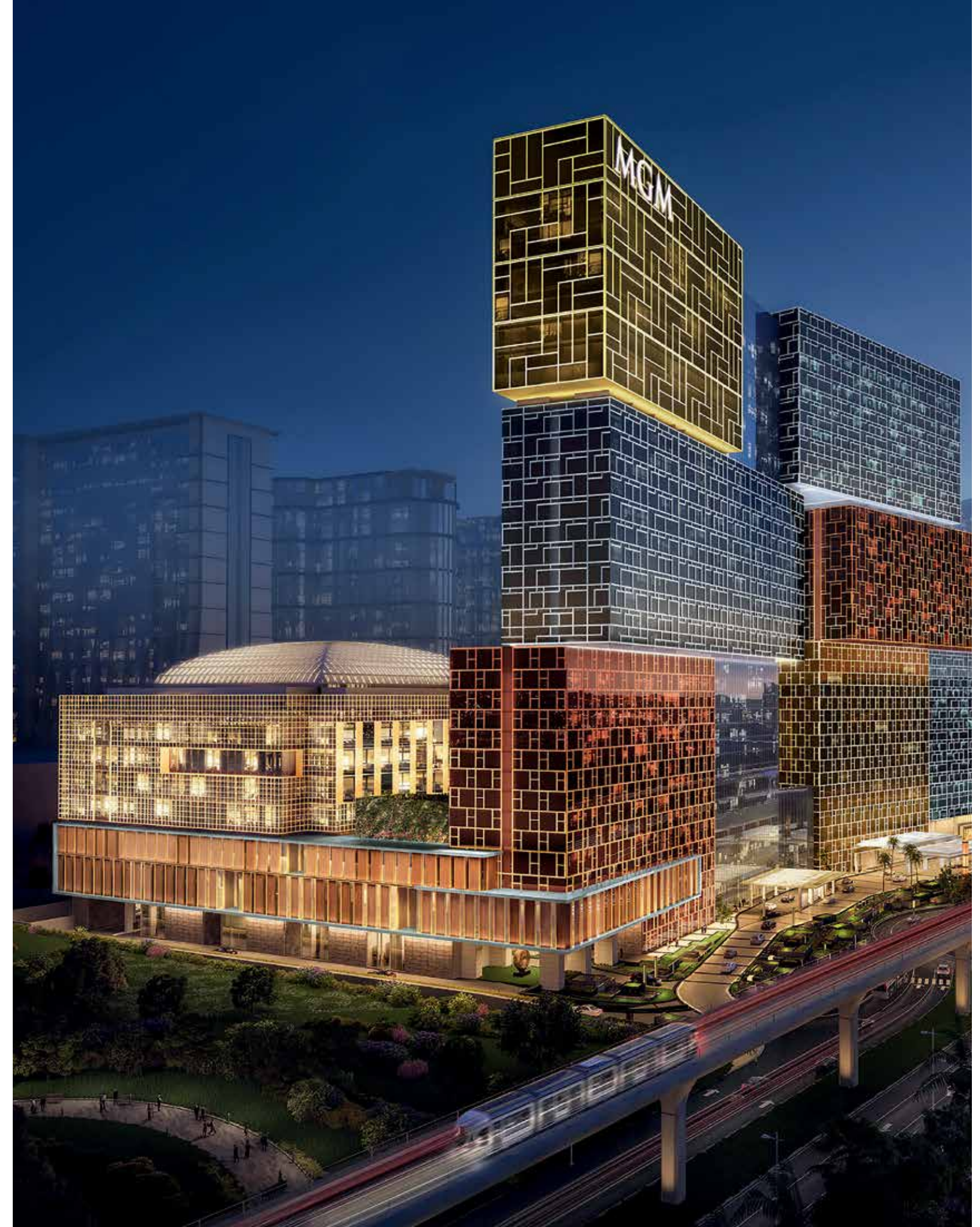
The installed seats stand out for their particular sides made of steel sheet, the shell has a visible wood backrest, the armrests are in steam-curved plywood. The gravity folding seat has anti-noise nylon joints, while the seat spring system is made by a special elastic fabric.

The city needed a multifunctional location that could lend itself to different types of events. The result was the amazing building designed by Studio Anselmi – Gandolfi – Passarelli, a futuristic project where Poltrona Frau Custom Interiors entirely manufactured the interiors.

1,400 armchairs with an innovative swivelling retracting action, furnish the main congress hall, the Concordia Hall. The special Poltrona Frau “Hide System” patent was applied here for the first time. This system enables the chairs to “retract” into the floor of the hall.





By activating a sophisticated electronic mechanism, the hall can be radically modified in its functions in a very short time: from an auditorium furnished for congress use, to an entirely empty space for trade fairs or other applications, with a total of 1,800 square metres floor space. Poltrona Frau also made approximately 1,000 Movie-model armchairs, for the five multi-purpose halls. All the partition units, the cladding of the perimeter walls with wood and metal panelling, and the wire net suspended ceilings, were included in Poltrona Frau's turnkey contract project.



Likewise, the foyer facilities on the ground floor, which comprise the welcome area, reception, cloakroom, information desk and leisure areas, are furnished with custom-made units manufactured specially by Poltrona Frau. A demanding and complex project that perfectly defines the company's expertise and long tradition in the production of superior quality seating combined with cutting-edge technological skills.

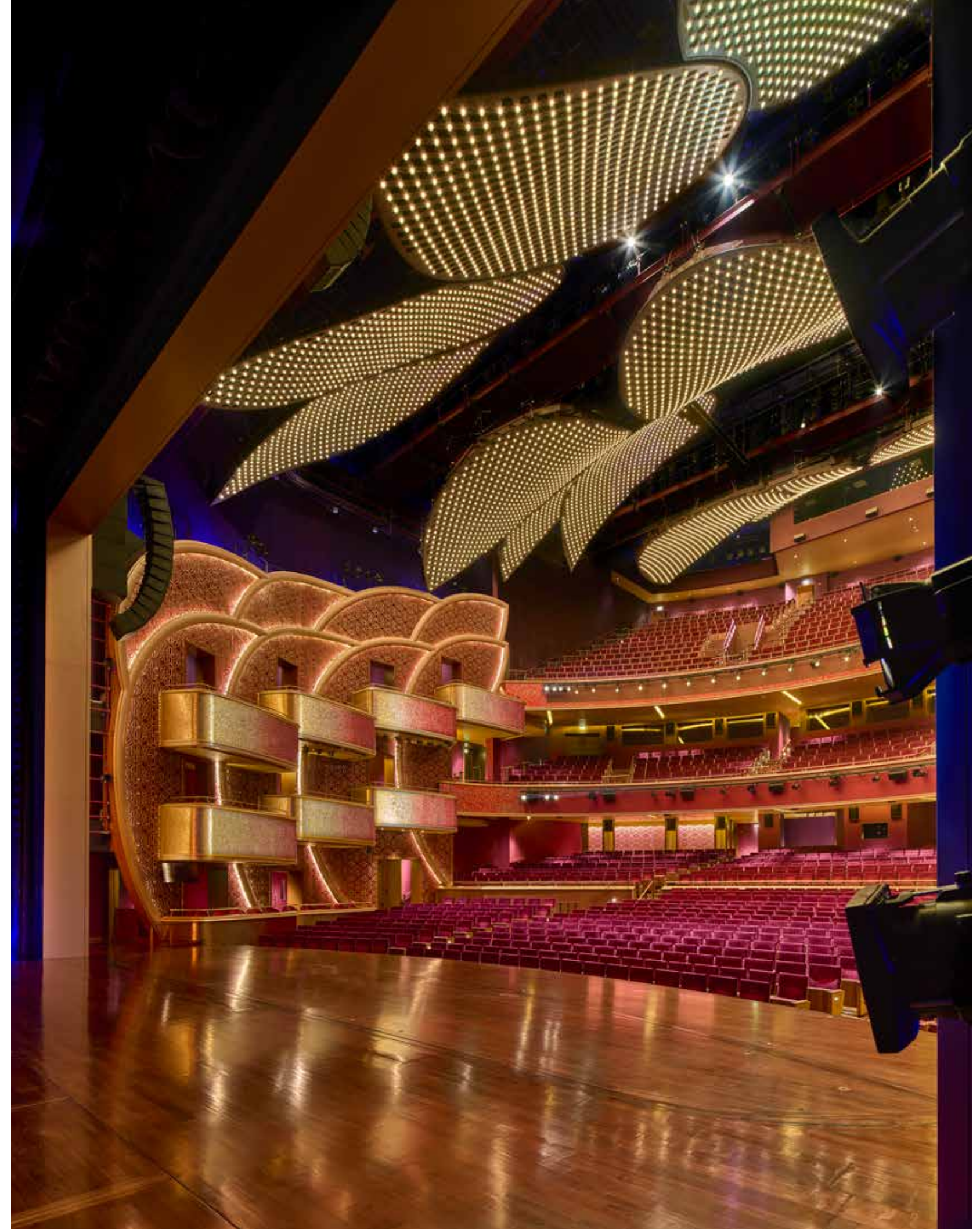

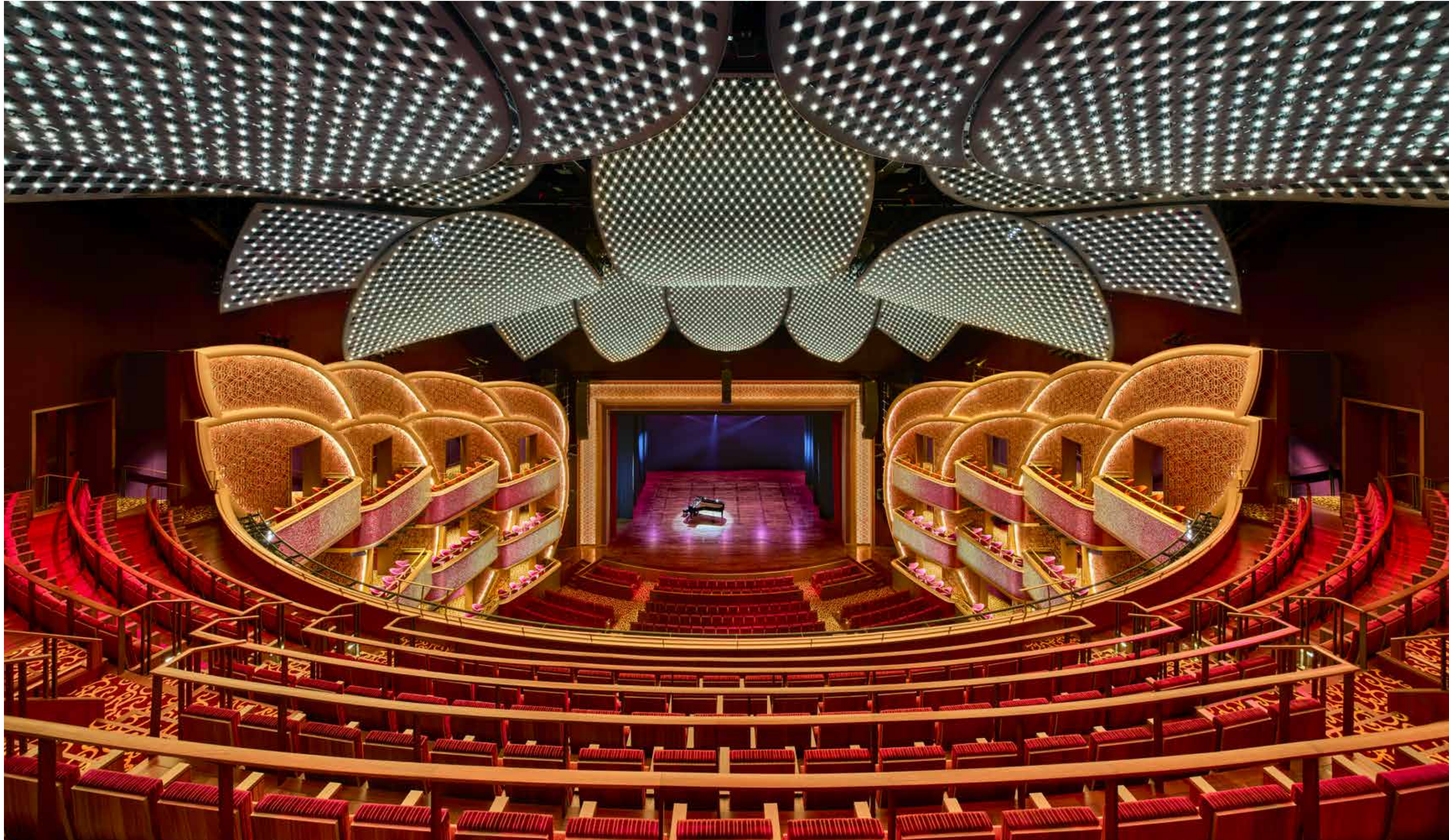

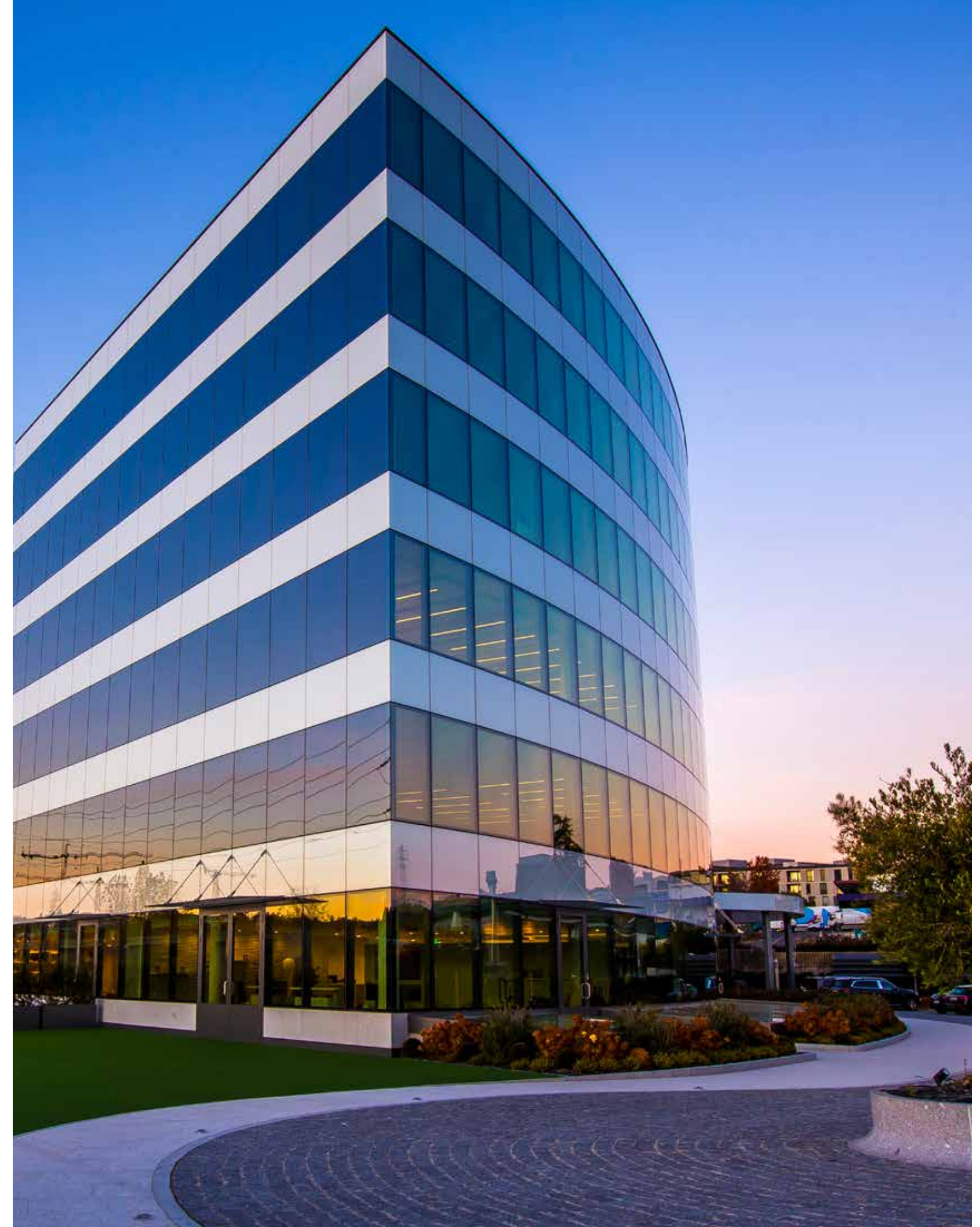

Each seat is equipped with a LED number projected onto the floor for easy identification, a side-mounted USB Type-C port, and 230v power outlets.

The Millennium Tower incorporates state-of-the-art technical facilities unique in Switzerland, so it cannot be a surprise that it has been awarded the 2023 Swiss Location Award. Kettering University

Kettering University, first known as The School of Automotive Trade, was founded in 1919 with the aim of training the new technical and management leaders of the growing automotive industry.

Today, Kettering University has become one of the strongest STEM institutions in the world. In 2022, they inaugurated the Learning Commons, an innovative facility that can adapt to multi-purpose educational and institutional events.

It is a one-of-a-kind building, with advanced technological spaces that encourage collaboration between students and faculty, nurturing innovation, and a cooperative learning model.





The facility includes a digital library, an auditorium, dining spaces, media resource centres, outdoor common spaces, and separate areas where students can stimulate teamwork or find their private study environment.

Poltrona Frau provided 206 Corum seats, a sophisticated solution designed by Poltrona Frau R.&D. Corum chair is made of a solid steel frame, padded fire-resistant polyurethane foam, and a spring system consisting of woven elastic belts. The silent counterweight system ensures the automatic retraction of the seat. The armchair sits on a steel base that is fixed to the floor and finished with epoxy powder paint.

For this project Stantec required a Trevi upholstery in three different colours, wood armrests with power and USB integration.

The Learning Commons is an innovative and flexible environment, where technology and human values share the same spaces. The same creative freshness that Poltrona Frau guarantees and has always provided in endless contract projects throughout the world.

The entire European Parliament and the large semicircular assembly room was fitted out with over 5000 seats, together with tables and benches equipped with telephony, data and electronic voting systems. The armchair created by Avant Travaux was produced with or without armrests and accessories and in a version for the disabled. Apart from the seating, all the furnishings for the semicircular room and the meeting rooms were made specially to order.





The challenge for Poltrona Frau's Custom Interiors Division was to furnish all of the spaces, and the Monsieur Pol chair took the limelight.

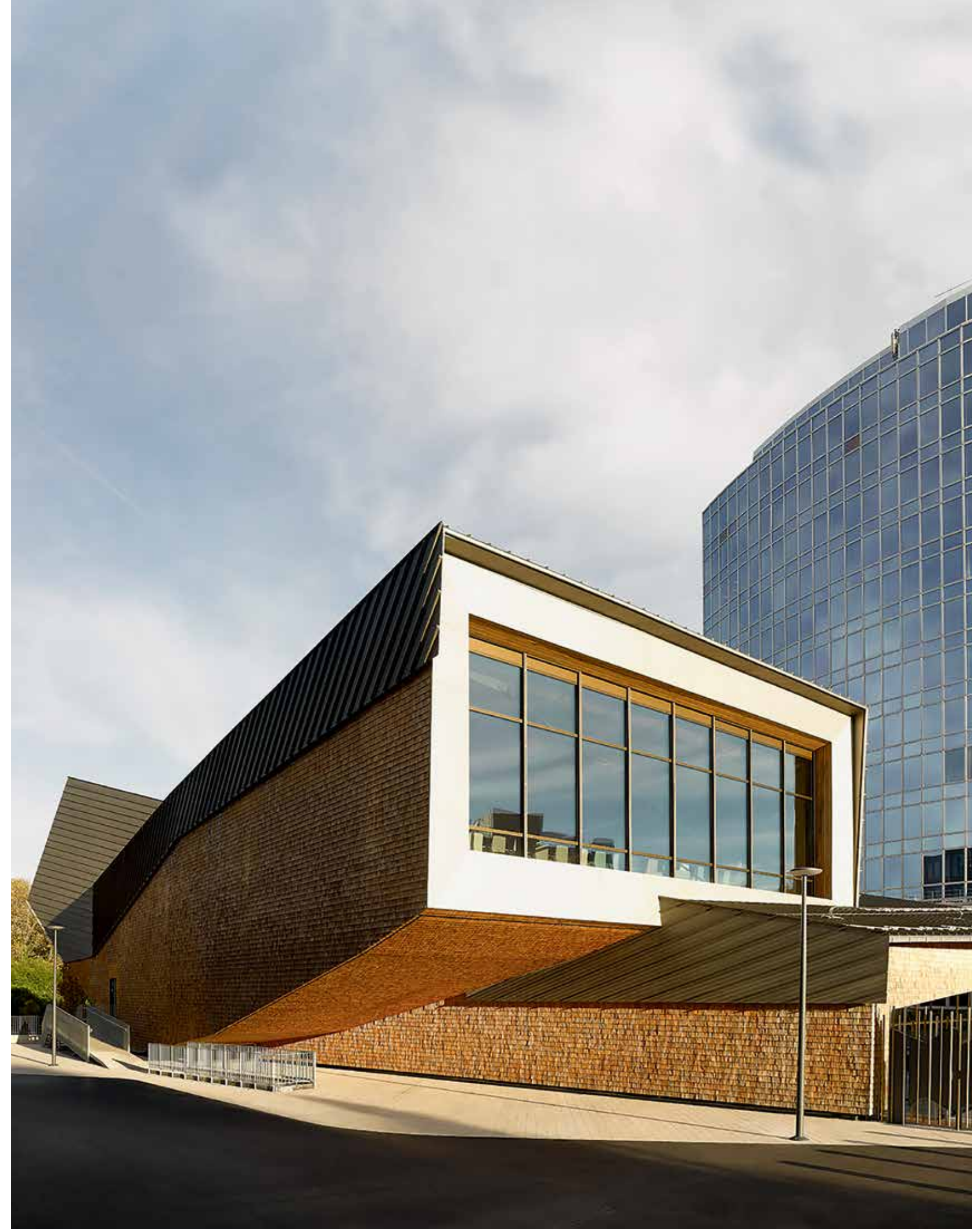

The new World Intellectual Property Organization's conference hall was specifically conceived and designed to meet the needs of the organization. All 900 seats, arranged around a single stage, are positioned in the space in an entirely non-hierarchical arrangement.

The room is therefore dynamic, comfortable and suitable for interaction between the representatives of the various countries. Several smaller meeting rooms complete the functionality of this state of the art conference hall.





Poltrona Frau Custom Interiors delivered seats that focused on ergonomics, functionality and space management. To install as many seats as possible in the space, Poltrona Frau, together with Behnisch Architekten, proposed a solution in which a seat can be mounted either on wheels or on a rail system.



Geneva Chair is available in high or low backrest versions, with or without armrests and in the leather colours of Pelle Frau® leather from the ColorSphere collection. The five-spoke metal base can come with or without wheels. As per the finest traditions of the Custom Interiors Division, the stitching and details can be customised in various ways and of course the special certifications required for public places can also be obtained.



This ensures the stability of the seats, which are fixed to the floor, whilst preserving their functionality. In fact, the seats can rotate to a right angle.

Given the innovative and technological characteristics of the seats Potrona Frau develop a complete collection for similar conference rooms. Given the link to the new WIPO conference hall in Geneva, the seats will be called Geneva Chair, a sinuous and elegant seat with a compact and light profile.

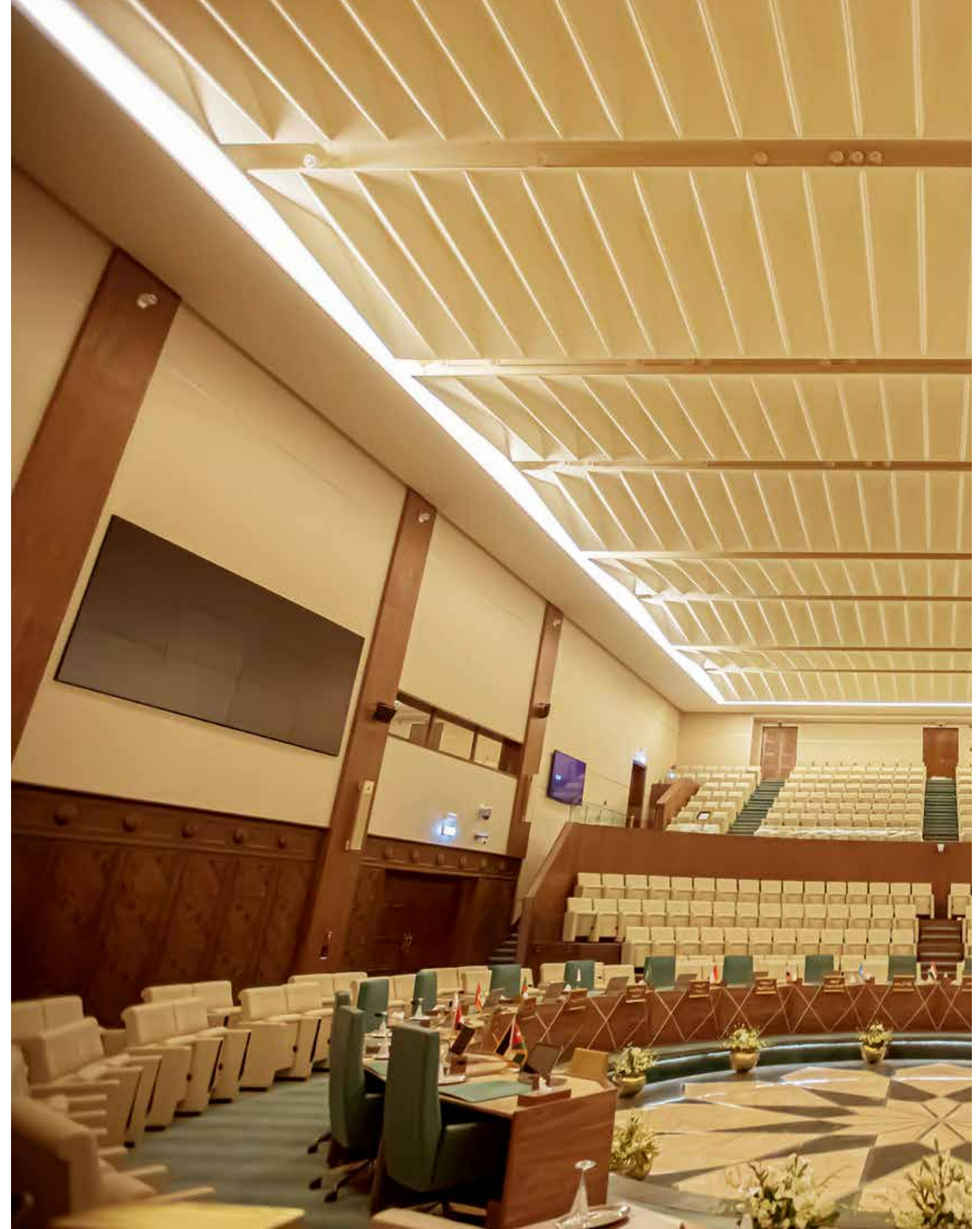

Arab League Hall

In 2015, Nada Debs, famous Lebanese designer, was appointed by the UAE for the renovation of the Arab League Hall in Cairo. The Hall was built in 1955 by the modernist architect Riad Mahmoud after the British Army left Egypt. It carries a strong symbolic value for the entire Arab world, therefore only a designer with a strong Arab identity and heritage, but with a contemporary taste and spirit, could fulfill such a demanding task. Poltrona Frau was asked to provide all the seating pieces, for its balance between heritage and modern vision.



Nada Debs explains that each Arab nation has its own identity, but they are all connected through geometry. Poltrona Frau respecting this attitude towards geometric lines provided the Chancellor seats for the delegates' round table. Their understated geometries and strong visual presence perfectly resemble the message of peace and dialogue that permeates the room. Their customized blue-green colour, also used for the floor, has a symbolic value and represents the fertile Arab region.



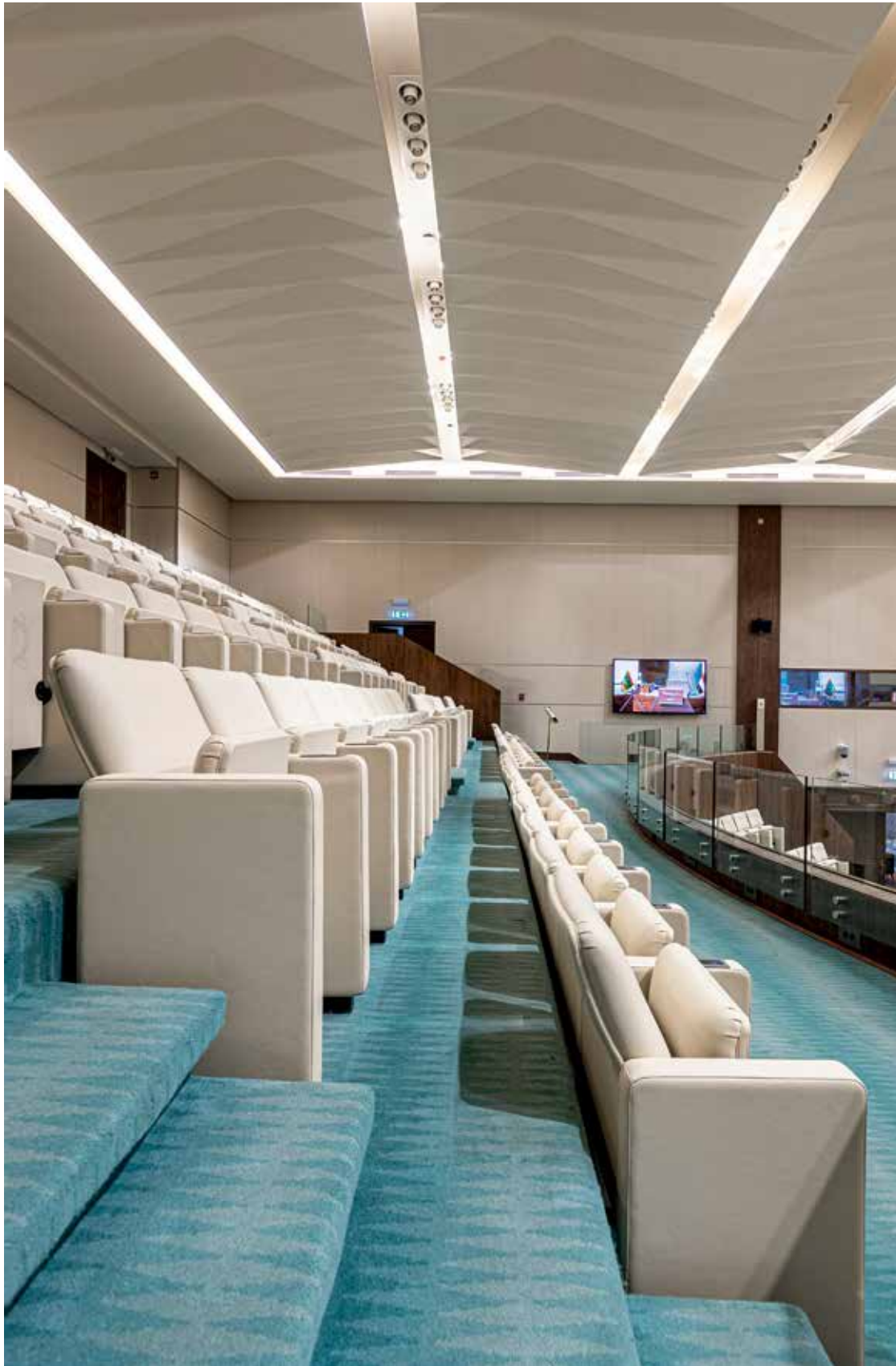

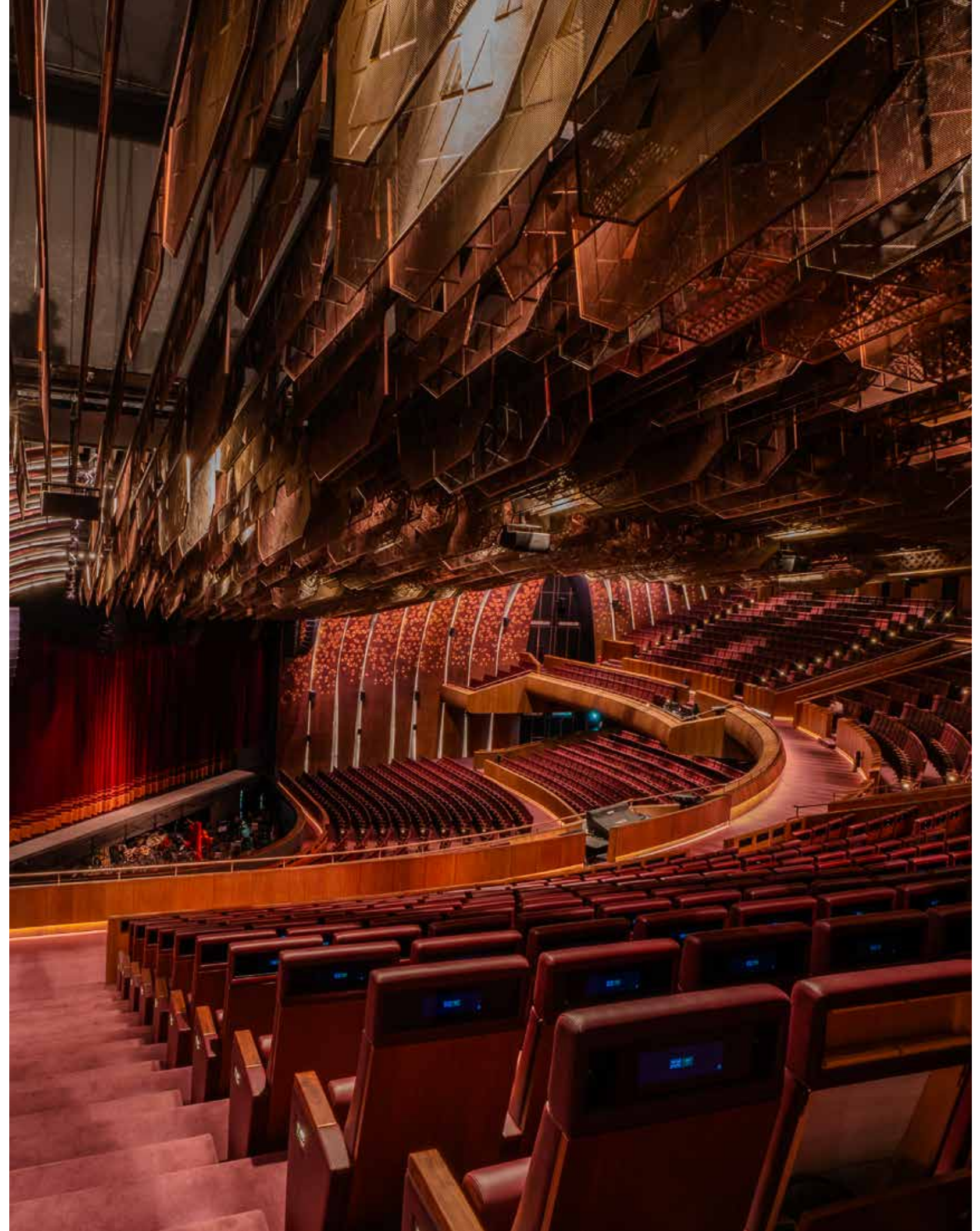

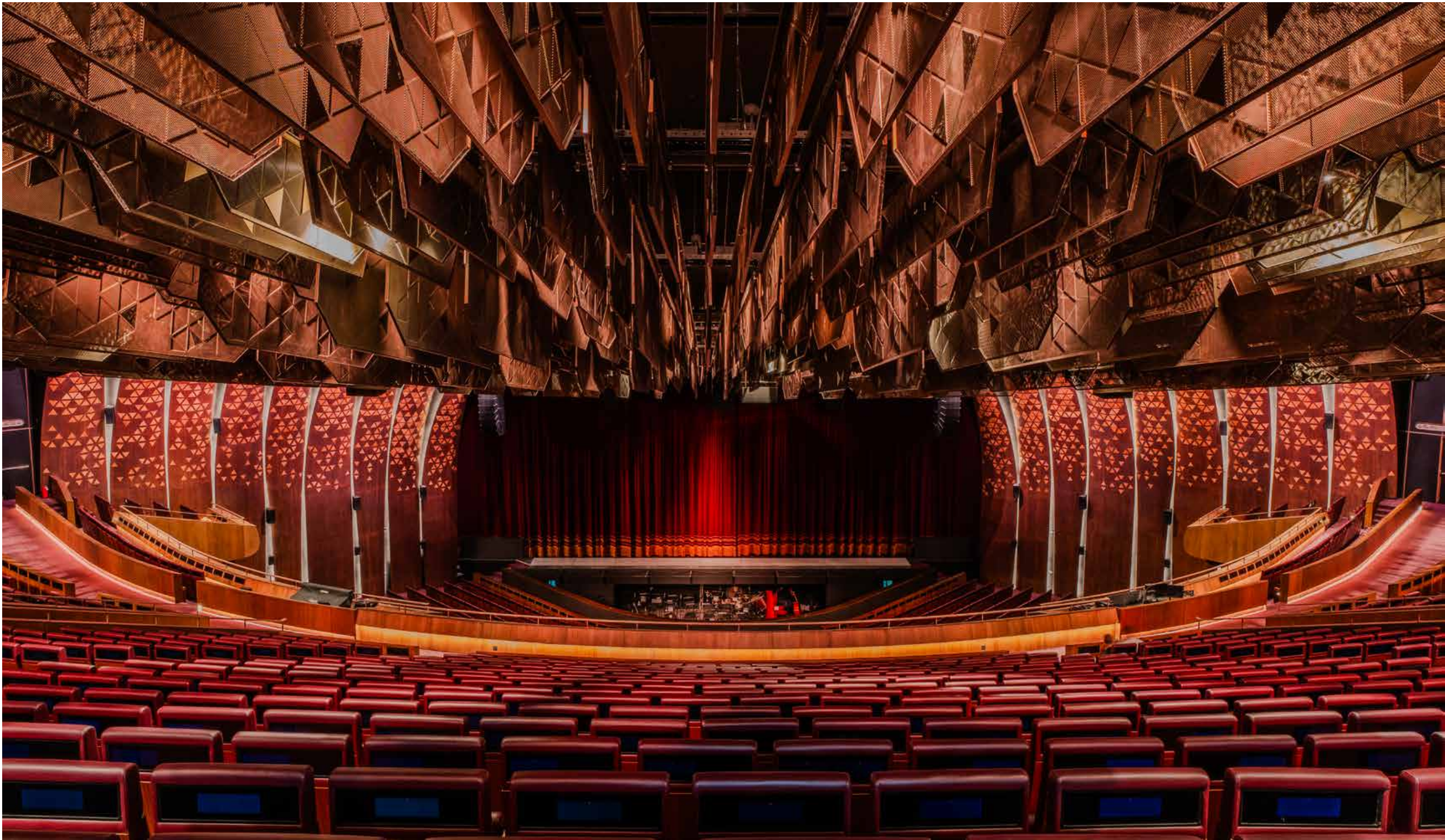

KFCC King Fahad Cultural Center

Originally constructed in 1987, on 2022 the Ministry of Culture took KFCC through an important renovation project developed by Giò Forma and managed by Black Engineering. The KFCC - King Fahad Cultural Center - is a cultural landmark of the city of Riyadh which also plays a key role in Saudi cultural life. It hosts exhibitions, artistic and cultural events, musical performances, film presentations; a complete offer for local and international audiences.





For the theatre Giò Forma and Black designed for Poltrona Frau the King Fahad chair; a pure expression of elegance and modernity. It embodies the classic style of theatre seating reinterpreted in a contemporary language. The leather and wood for an ancient and traditional style, the brass for an extra precious elegance, and the integrated touch screen confirming its contemporary and technological vocation.

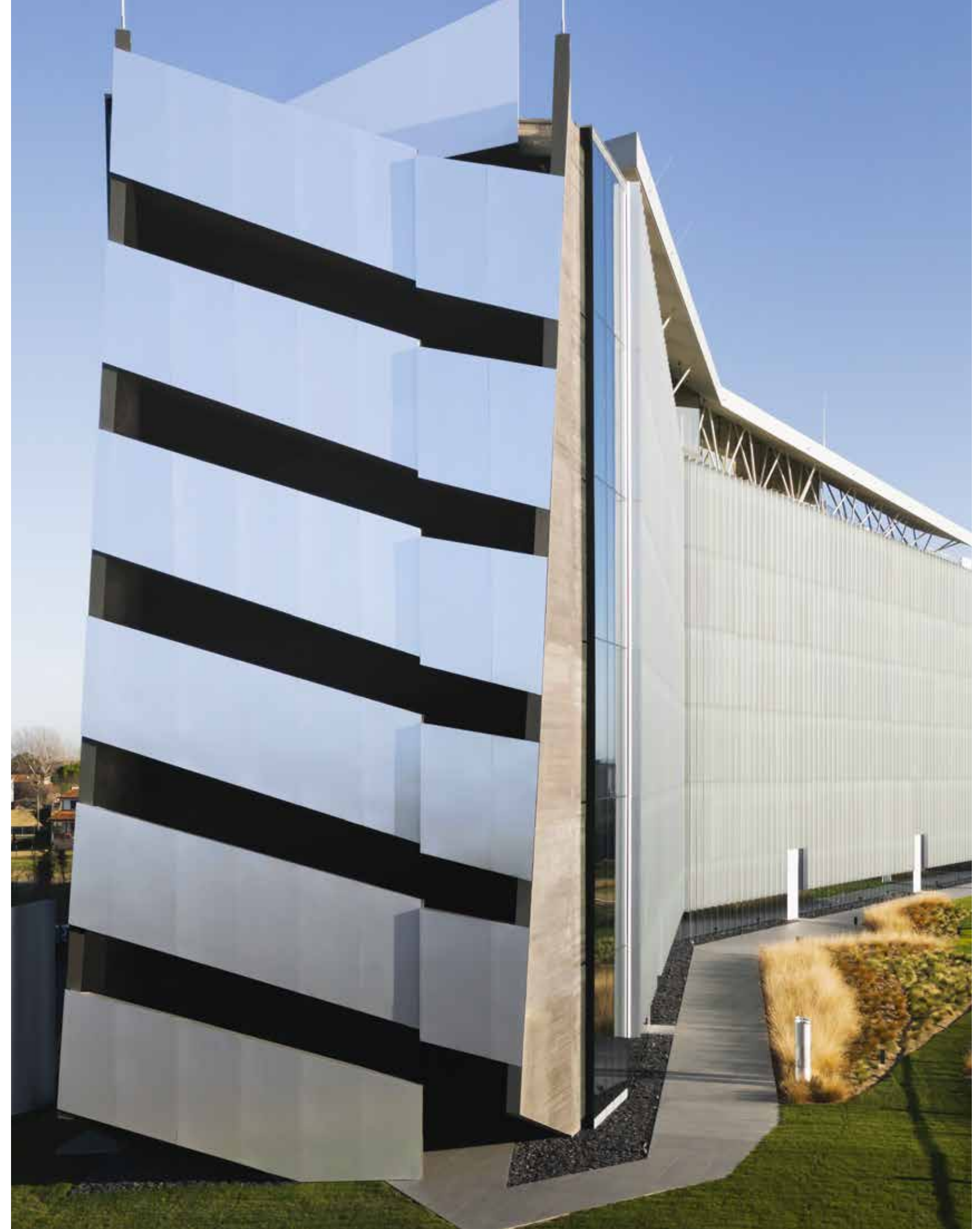

Sidera, the new headquarters for CONAD (Italian Consortium of Shop Owners) is a futuristic building in glass and steel. 33 meters high and over 100 meters long for 10.000 square meters of office space designed according to the most modern principles of neuro-architecture.

The shape of the building represents the rational and pragmatic spirit of the cooperative, but at the same time, Sidera can be considered a living organism where light, air, acoustics, and visual sensations are perfectly calibrated creating a favourable working environment.





A pioneer project where the architects have considered even its birds eye view, typical of satellite and GPS mapping. A pitched roof, very unusual in industrial architecture, with six flaps recalling the Apennine mountains which give space to three large size skylight windows.



Contemporary architecture design and nature, cooperation between workers together with the desire of creating favourable working environments; these are values that Poltrona Frau has shared with Conad for the seating of their assembly hall, where the cooperative holds its meeting. 200 BCN seats designed by Herzog & De Meuron, characterized by solid geometric volumes and here upholstered in fireproof and soundproof fabric, according to acoustic regulations.

The Neo-Renaissance palace designed by Miklós Ybl had been open to opera and ballet lovers for more than one hundred thirty years when it underwent an extensive renovation project that lasted for nearly five years.

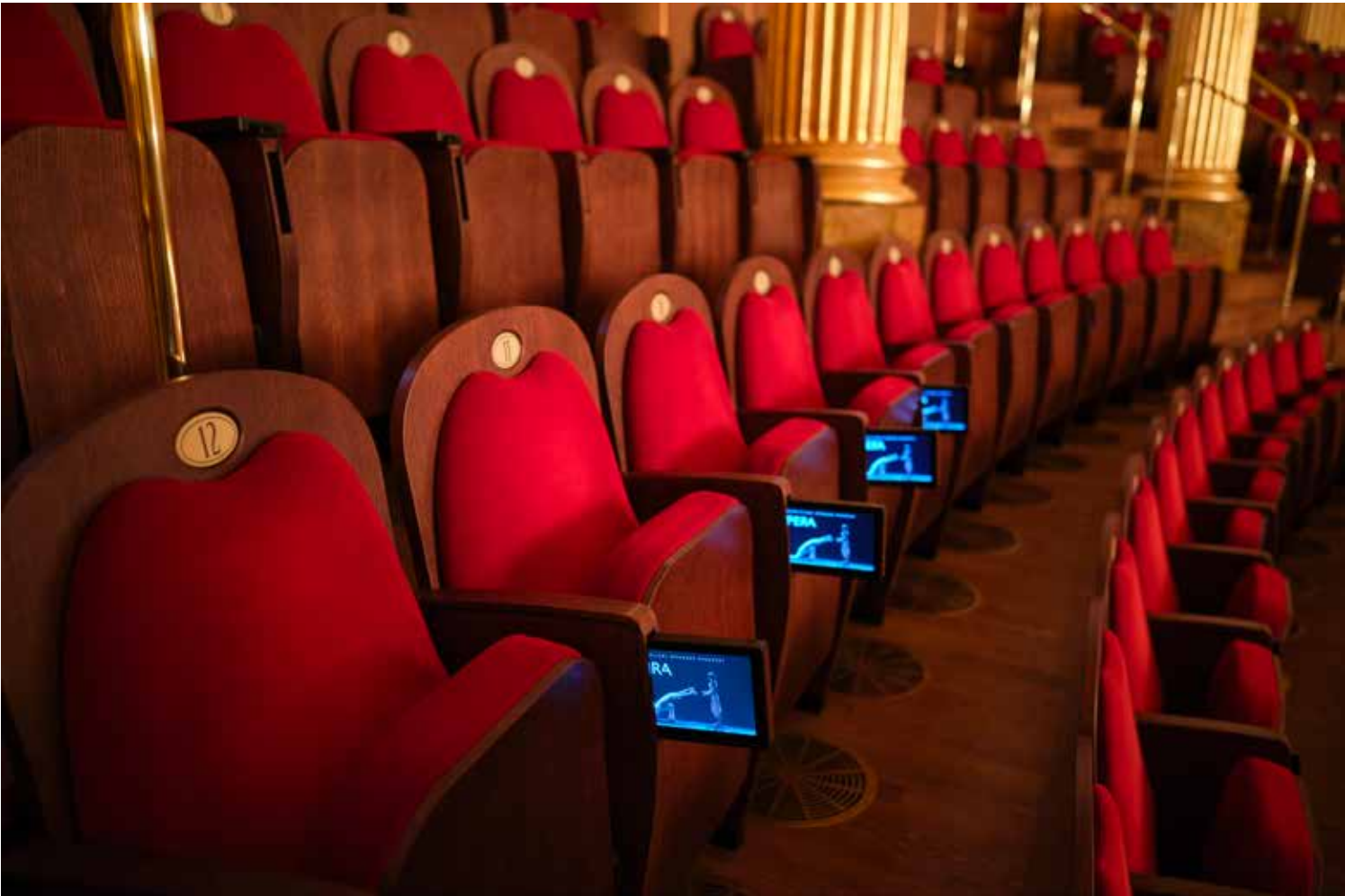
The challenging task for Poltrona Frau Custom Interiors was to recreate the original atmosphere but remaining compliant to the new safety, acoustic and comfort requirements.

For the new auditorium they provided 1200 seats upholstered in red velvet as in the original version, but the rows have been set further apart and the seats are larger and more comfortable. For this project, Poltrona Frau has also given its contribution in the study and perfecting of the acoustics and the seating layout to improve visibility from all points of the theatre.

Stadttheater

The oldest baroque theatre in Switzerland still in activity. The Stadttheatre in Solothurn dates back to the 17th century. It was first used for the performances of the Jesuits' school, and from the middle of the 19th century until today there has been a regular and professional production of comedies and classic plays, opera and ballet. In 2013-14 it underwent a massive renovation project designed by Zurich architects Phalt Architekten AG mainly for safety and practical reasons. The project also became the occasion to expand the theatre by including the “Haus Krieg” building creating a more spacious entrance and a bar area for the audience.





The end result was a location where history and modern technology worked as one. Poltrona Frau contributed providing the 280 custom-made chairs with solid wood sides and wooden seating and back panels upholstered in with velvet fabric. Poltrona Frau furnished two different types of seats, the first for the parterre and the first-row seats of the balcony, while the second type was used for the second-row balcony seats.



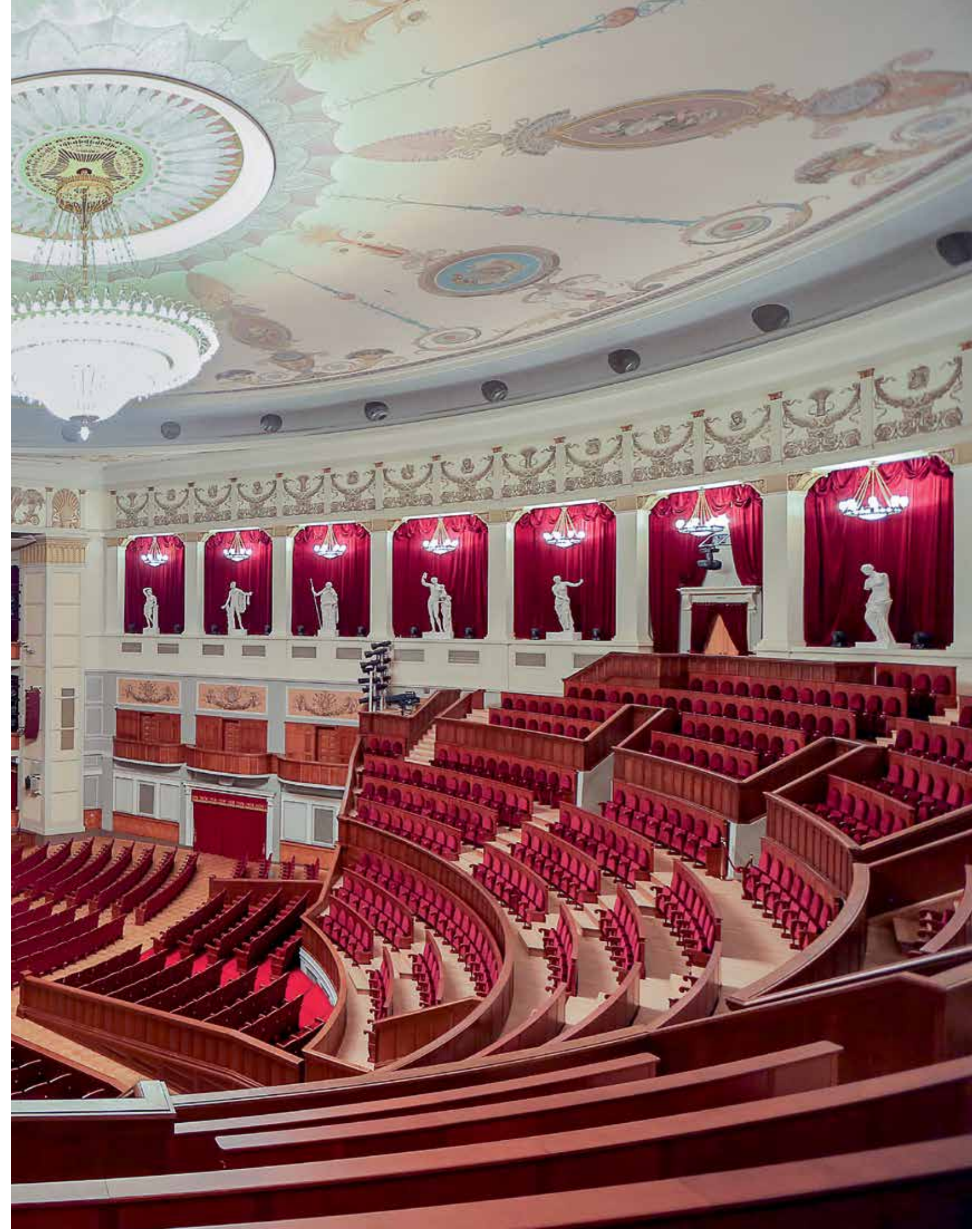
The latter, were provided with an innovative mechanism that lowered the footrest while lowering the seat. Poltrona Frau with its historical tradition, craftsmanship and expertise in the chair design sector combined with the technological knowledge acquired project after project, is the ideal partner for any seating design. Every project managed by Poltrona Frau Custom Interiors is a journey in history, style and state-of-the-art technology.



Academic Theatre of Opera and Ballet

The Novosibirsk State Academic Theatre of Opera and Ballet is the main symbol of the Siberian city of Novosibirsk. It's the only theatre in the world, which was built and unveiled during World War II.

It's also often called the "Siberian Colosseum" for its huge size, extension and beauty. The authors of the project wanted to create a huge panoramic theatre, where the cars, tractors, tanks could appear on the stage right from the street. The construction of the theatre was completed in February 1944, and the first performance was held on May 12th, 1945. It is the largest theatre in Russia, larger than the Bolshoi Theatre in Moscow.



Thanks to its long-time experience and know-how, in 2018, Poltrona Frau Custom Interiors was asked to completely refurbish the 1600 historical seats of the entire theatre, both in the main auditorium and balconies and in the Small Hall. The project, completely custom made, started from the original blueprints dating back to the 1930's focusing on comfort, quality of the materials while guaranteeing an improved stage visibility.

The renovation included specific custom-made carpentry work for the panels and thrones of the surrounding balconies. The original design and project were completely respected and preserved in the style and colouring. On the contrary, even though the Novat theatre preserves its historical look, it surprisingly is the most technologically advanced theatre in Russia, and for this reason it stages some of the most important national and international festivals.



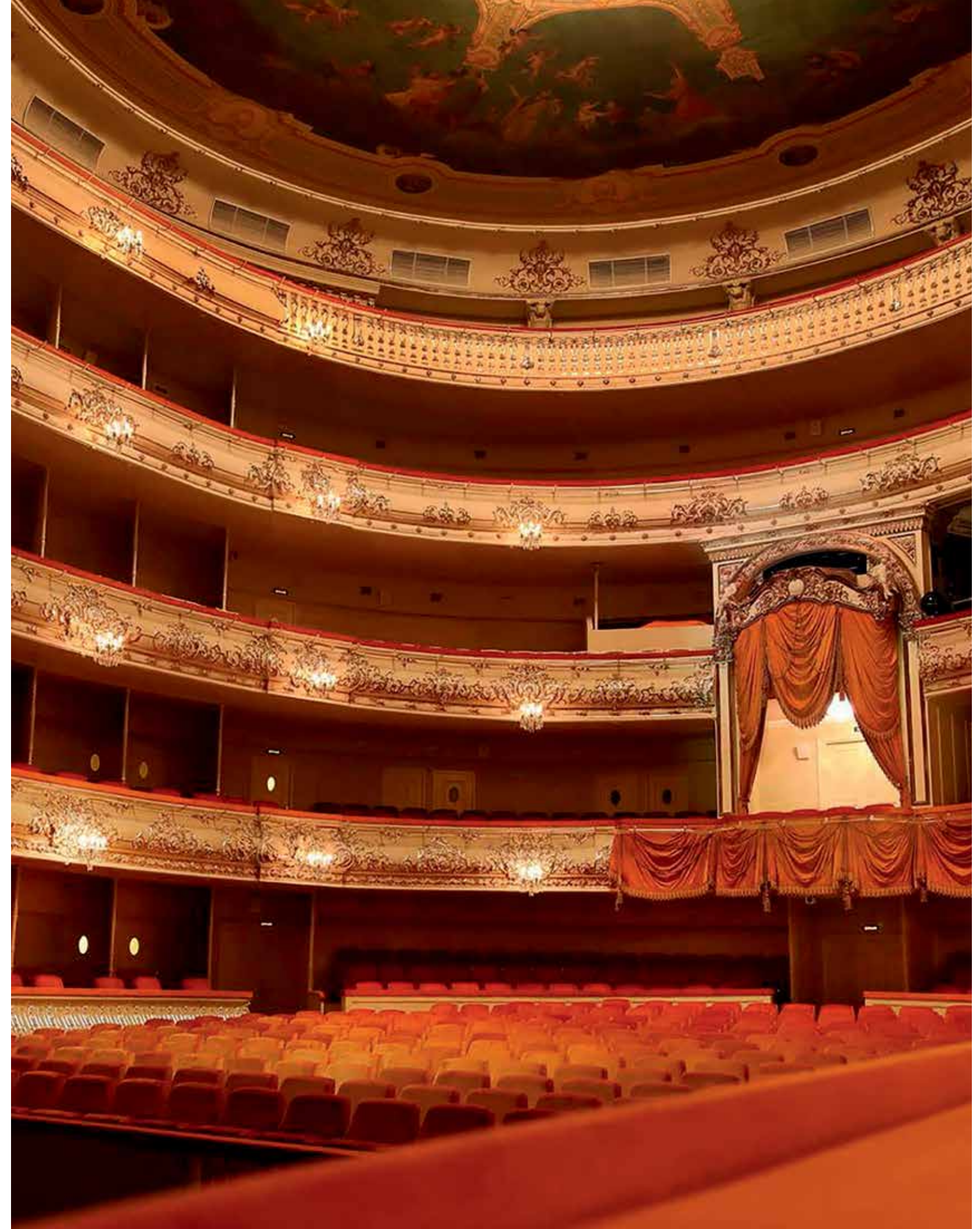

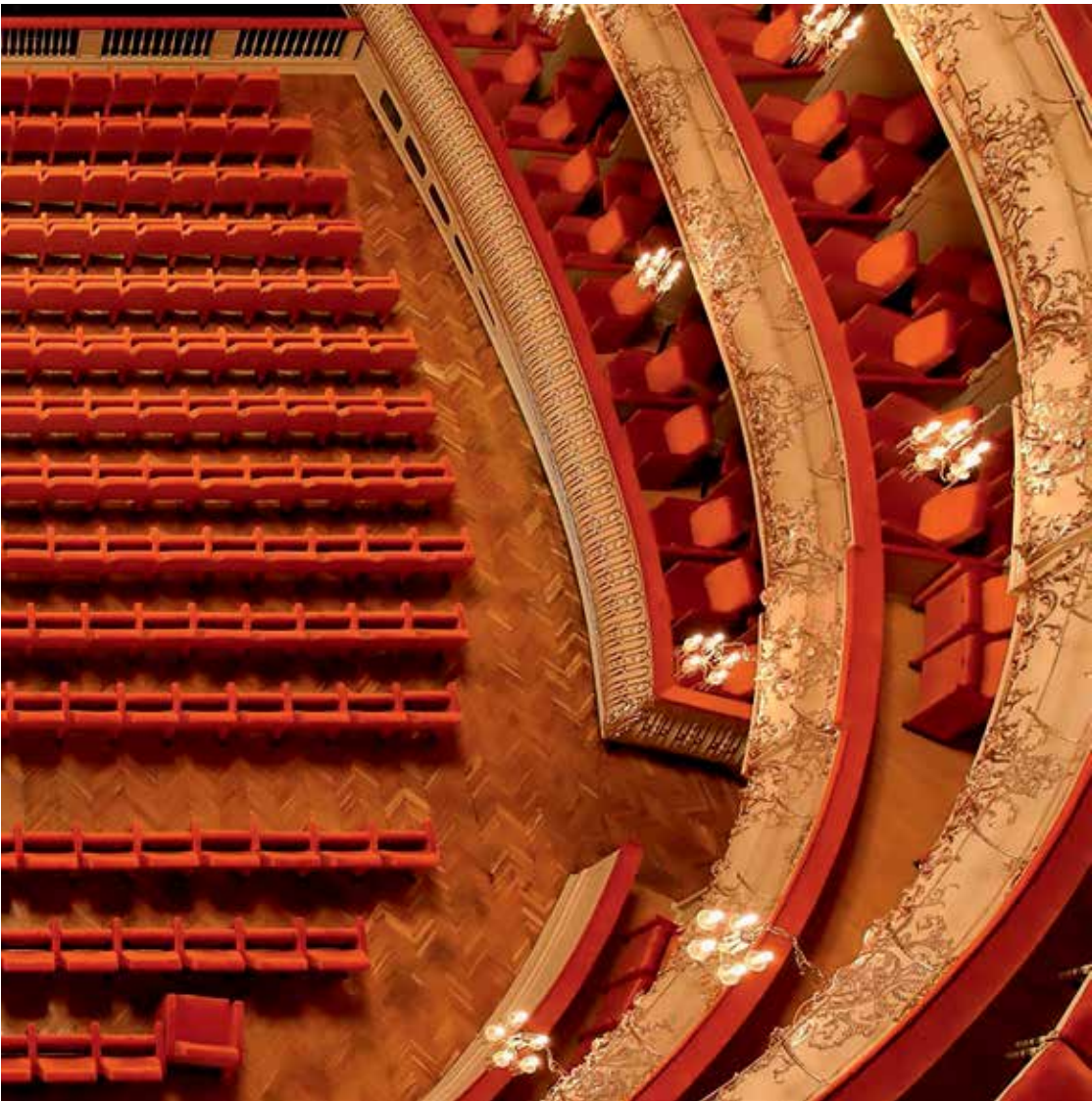
